SUPERINTENDENT'S AGENDA: ACTION ITEM

On Monday evening, following the State of the Schools Address at York High School, the D205 Board of Education voted 5-0, two members being absent, to authorize Board President Kara Caforio to sign a Memorandum of Understanding outlining the principles of a comprehensive intergovernmental cooperation agreement to address the stormwater management interests of the City at Jackson Elementary and York High School. The City also will contribute TIF funds and other sources to help improve other basic facility needs of District 205.

The principles are set forth in a document which Elmhurst Mayor Steven Morley signed on September 17, 2018, and President Caforio later signed on September 18, 2018.

The formal comprehensive agreement is expected to be completed and presented for approval and signature by the City Council and the Board of Education in late October.
