Admissions Process

What is the timeline for the Admissions Process at Roman Catholic High School?

- Fall 2018: Register for the High School Entrance Test (One of three offered)
 - Registration confirmed by mail
- Sunday, September 23, 2018: Student Discovery Day
- Sunday, October 14, 2018: Roman Catholic Open House
- Scholarship Entrance Test
 - October 27, 2018
 - November 17, 2018
 - December 8, 2018
- Mid-December, 2018 Submit (These are required for the completion of the admissions process):
 - a) 7th grade report card
 - b) 7th grade standardized test scores
 - c) 8th grade first trimester report card
 - d) Student Recommendation Form
- Decision letters will be mailed in January
- Fall 2019: Welcome to Roman Catholic High School!
- June 2023: Graduation!

The admissions process for students desiring entrance to 9th grade at Roman Catholic High School begins with the High School Placement Test (HSPT). Any student wishing to attend Roman Catholic is required to take the HSPT.

Registration for the HSPT (Scholarship Entrance Test) is processed through the online application. Visit RomanCatholicHS.com to register and make the \$50 non-refundable payment no later than five days before the testing date.

What scholarships and financial aid are available at Roman Catholic High School?

Academic scholarships for Roman Catholic High School are based on the scores of the HSPT. Financial Aid and Tuition Assistance can be applied for using the common FACTS Tuition Aid Form which will be available in the Fall. ***Any assistance awarded from Roman Catholic REQUIRES completion of this form. All external academic grants WILL also REQUIRE the FACTS Aid application to be complete.*** To apply for financial aid, visit <https://online.factsmtg.com/aid> to begin online application (recommended completion date is December 31, 2018) For assistance with the application call FACTS: 866-441-4637.

When will I be notified of my acceptance to Roman Catholic High School?

Decision letters are mailed on a rolling basis after the last test date. Some students may be required to schedule an admissions interview based on the request of a Roman Catholic High School administrator.

What should I do after I take the High School Entrance Test?

Visit Roman Catholic. Aside from Student Discovery Day and Open House, setting up a “Shadow Day” at Roman is one of the best ways to become better acquainted with the RCHS family. Visit RomanCatholicHS.com/shadowday to register for a “Shadow Day.”
