Like any time throughout the school year, it is School District 2 policy that all community members must show an ID and be buzzed into the main entrance to the building. Once inside, you must check in at the office and wear a visitor's badge. Please expect staff to ask you to return to the main office if they see you without a visitor's sticker. These procedures have been put in place to protect your children, so please be kind to the office staff when they ask for your ID as well as the reason for your visit.

**Breakfast:** Breakfast is served at Bench from 7:45 to 8:05 and all children are expected to eat breakfast prior to going out to morning walk. Please make sure your child arrives on time each day to ensure they are able to enjoy a full breakfast. If your child arrives between 8:05 and 8:40 they will be offered a late breakfast which consists of milk, a breakfast bar and a fruit. Students will take these items to class to enjoy while participating in their class learning activities. **Students arriving after 8:40 should try their best to eat at home prior to coming to school.** Morning snack is provided Tuesday through Thursday.
