#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Beresford provided an update to the Board on his "Big Rocks/Goals" for the year which included the following:
  - **Design and Construction of New Elementary Schools-**-Dr. Beresford reported that a Project Visioning Committee has been established. This committee is comprised of elementary principals, ESC administrators, architects and design specialists who are researching design features and what an ideal educational space would look like. Dr. Beresford also shared that focus groups are being held with teachers at different schools.
  - Exploring Changes in the School Day--Dr. Beresford reported that discussions have occurred with administrators about the topic of exploring changes in the school day for elementary and secondary. Administrators are now receiving teacher feedback on this topic. Parents will have an opportunity to share their feedback in the near future.
  - **High Ability Service Delivery Models--** The timeline for the high ability service delivery model has been pushed back to the second semester. All stakeholders will have an opportunity to share their feedback in the near future.
  - **Teacher Talent Development System**—a new evaluation system for educators is being developed. This system is motivational in nature instead of a rubric evaluation. The administrative committee met two weeks ago and the joint committee between administrators and teachers will be held on October 31st.
  - Communication Systems—Dr. Beresford shared that the website redesign is progressing and the new design is expected to launch over winter break. He emphasized that MyCCS is retiring in December and CCS will be implementing a new Powerschool Parent Portal. Parents with students with the last names of A-L have received an email with an access ID code to create an account. In addition, Dr. Beresford stated he is looking forward to a December launch of the Stop It! App, a two way anonymous reporting app.
- Dr. Beresford highlighted the following student and team achievements:
  - Marching Greyhounds won the Bands of America Super Regional Championships.
  - CHS JV Cheerleaders won the Indiana State Cheer Championships and the CHS Cheer team was named the state's runners-up in the stunt group.
  - CHS Girls Soccer Team won Semi-State and they are headed to the IHSAA State Finals.
  - The Greyhound Unified Bocce Ball Team was named state runner-ups.
  - The CHS Boys Tennis Team won their third straight IHSAA State Championship.
  - CHS student Presley Theinenman won the IHSAA Boys Singles State Championship--this is the 3rd consecutive Greyhound to win this title.
  - The CHS Boys Tennis Double Team of Timmy Dixon and Garrett Lloyd earned the title of IHSAA Boys State Runner-Up.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT (CON'T.)

- Dr. Beresford shared with the board that there is a Parent School Safety Academy Informational Meeting that will be held on November 7th at Clay Middle School at 6:30 p.m.
- Dr. Beresford stated that he is excited about the Carmel Education Foundation's annual Ghosts and Goblins run this Saturday, October 27th. He encouraged everyone to participate in this race to help support education grants for CCS teachers.
- Dr. Beresford reported that last week was National School Lunch Week. He said he had a great time visiting West Clay Elementary and helping serve food in the lunch line.
- Dr. Beresford shared that this week is America's Safe Schools Week and that all the schools in the district are communicating safety tips to students throughout the week. He also stated it is School Bus Drivers, Monitors, Aides and Bus Mechanic's Appreciation Week.
- Dr. Beresford stated that 25% of the school year is complete and that report cards will be sent home via email this Friday, October 26th.
