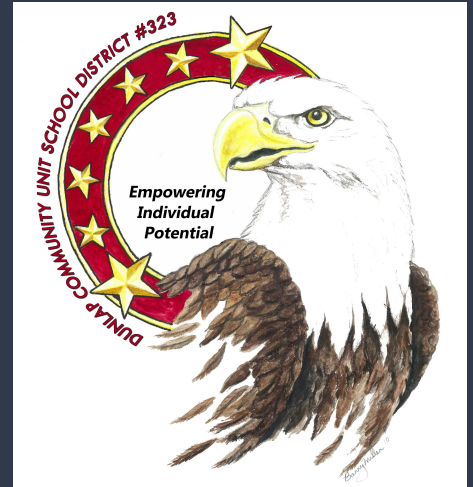

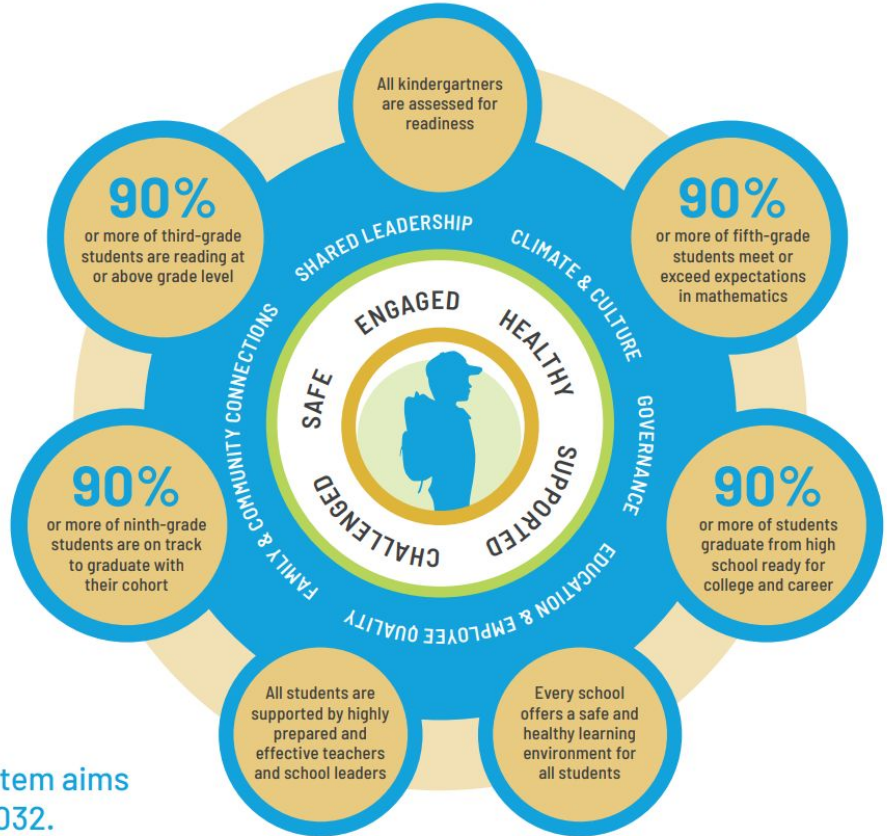

# ISBE Goals: What is best for children and how can we get there?



## Long Term Academic Goals

90% or more

- 3rd Graders **reading** at or above grade level
- 5th Grade students meet or achieve expectations in **math**
- 9th grade students are on track to **graduate** with cohort
- Students graduate from high school **college and career ready**

# Elementary and Middle School Criteria: Determining Summative Ratings

## 75% - Academic Indicators

- ▶ PARCC and DLM
  - ▷ ELA **10%**
  - ▷ Math **10%**
    - ▷ **7.5% each** in 2019
- ▶ Growth on PARCC or DLM, **50%**
- ▶ EL Proficiency, **5%**
  - ▷ ACCESS Test
- ▶ *Science, 5% starting 2019-20*

## 25% - School Quality/Student Success Indicators

- ▶ Chronic Absenteeism, **10%**
- ▶ Climate Survey, **5%**
- ▶ PreK-2 Indicator, **5%**
- ▶ Elementary/Middle Indicator, **5%**

# High School Criteria: Determining Summative Ratings

## 75% - Academic Indicators

- ▶ SAT
  - ▷ ELA **10%**
  - ▷ Math **10%**
    - ▷ **7.5% each** in 2019
- ▶ Graduation (4-, 5-, and 6-year rates), **50%**
- ▶ EL Proficiency, **5%**
  - ▷ ACCESS Test
- ▶ Science, *5% starting 2019-20*

## 25% - School Quality/Student Success Indicators

- ▶ Chronic Absenteeism, **7.5%**
- ▶ Ninth Grade on Track, **6.25%**
- ▶ College and Career Ready, **6.25%**
- ▶ Climate Survey, **5%**

# Four Tiered Ratings

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No Underperforming subgroups</li><li>• Graduation rate higher than 67 percent</li><li>• Performance among top 10% of schools statewide</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No Underperforming subgroups</li><li>• Graduation rate higher than 67 percent</li><li>• Performance <u>NOT</u> among top 10% of schools statewide</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One or more underperforming subgroups at “all-students” level of lowest 5 percent of Title I schools</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the lowest- performing 5% of Title I schools in Illinois</li><li>• HS Graduation rate less than 67% or less</li></ul>
