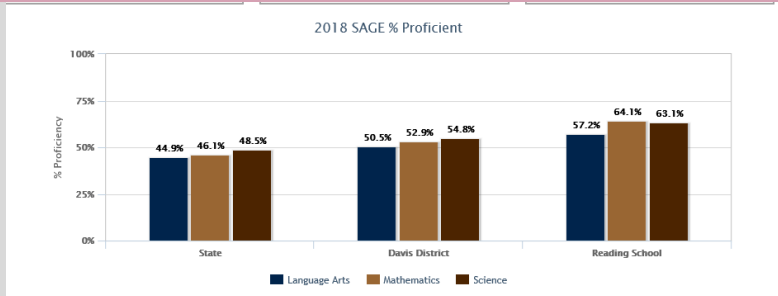

ENGLISH LANGAGE ARTS: Third-sixth grade students at Reading Elementary outperformed their peers across Davis District by 6.7% and across the state by 12.3%!

MATH: Third-sixth grade students at Reading Elementary outperformed their peers across Davis District by 11.2% and across the state by 18%!

SCIENCE: Fourth-sixth grade students at Reading Elementary outperformed their peers across Davis District by 8.3% and across the state by 14.6%!
