Students in grades K-2 will not receive letter grades. Students in grades K - 2 will receive evaluations that specify strengths and weaknesses in each subject area. The student's social and physical development will also be evaluated. Each student's progress will be reviewed with the parent in designated parent/teacher conferences, or conferences may be scheduled by contacting the appropriate teacher, Building Head, or Head of School. Students in grades 3-12 will receive letter grades with written reports. Grades 3-12 will be evaluated using a 10-point grading scale.

Conventional grades, when used for students in grades 3-12, will represent the following 10-point scale:

100 - 90 A
89 - 80 B
79 - 70 C
69 - 60 D
59 and below is work that is unsatisfactory.
