### **Technology Update**

The refresh did not have enough money funded from the district to pay for laptop carts. Money for 2 carts has been allocated but there currently isn't a need for them without purchasing new technology. Sound systems haven't had to be replaced, they just need minor repairs. 15 projectors have been purchased and 6 have already been replaced. Lightning cords have been purchased- came in under budget on those. Mice have been purchased and we saved about \$3. Headsets have been purchased but haven't been received or invoiced. 39K was allocated and approximately \$14 has been spent.
