### Who makes up the voting members of KHS Governance Council?

- 7 Parents/Guardians of students at KHS, 5 Teachers, 2 Community Members

### Who can attend this open meeting?

- All KHS parents/guardians and members of the greater Killingly community

### What does the KHS Governance Council do?

- Advise school administration on issues of communication, policies and student achievement
- Analyze school achievement data and provide feedback on how to improve academic standards
- Advise principal on budget initiatives and review draft budget to ensure community input

### What is the KHS Governance Council's Mission and why is it important to our school?

- Improved communication between school and parents
- Enable parents, school staff, and community leaders to work together to improve student achievement
- Facilitate communication of educational goals and standards to parents and community

### How can you get involved with the KHS Governance Council?
