

## Criteria and Rubric for Selection to the Alumni Hall of Fame

1. The nominee is a graduate of Carmel High School for at least ten years at the time of initial nomination.
2. The nominee has displayed exemplary achievement in the nominee’s area of specialization. (50%)
3. The nominee has received recognition, honors, and awards on the local, regional, national, or international level. (20%)
4. The nominee has demonstrated service to the community in which they live or have lived. (30%)
5. A personal statement of 250 words or less by the nominator illuminating the nominee’s impact and contributions that warrant the nominee’s selection to the Carmel High School Alumni Hall of Fame.
