### The Basics of Floor Hockey

- Forwards and center are the only players allowed past half court on the team's offensive side. The center, backs, and goalie are the only players allowed on the team's defensive side.
- The object is to get the ball into the goal (without entering the crease). The team with the most goals wins.
- Players are not allowed to check, hook, or contact another player with their stick.
- ALL players must wear a mouth guard and protective eye wear
