First and foremost, while you are abroad you are acting as an ambassador of the United States and more specifically as an ambassador of The Marvelwood School. This is a position that is not to be taken lightly, as your time with the host school will leave a deep and lasting impression that will impact future trips. Please read and understand the following points:

- You must act positively as a member of The Marvelwood School and fulfill your responsibilities as a conference delegate.
- While visiting India, you must abide by their laws.
- You will write an article for the school's magazine, the Blue and White, upon your return.
- You will speak at School Meeting and other events about the experience.
- Marvelwood's student code of conduct remains in effect while you are abroad, and violation of major school rules while on the trip will result in severe consequences.

To complete the application, please submit the following documents to Registrar Shannon Nelson by January 15, 2019. Interviews will take place January 21-25, and candidates will be notified of their selection by mid-February.
