Congratulations! You have taken the first step towards being a delegate for the Round Square International Conference by obtaining this packet and applying for the trip. The Marvelwood School is excited to be able to offer the opportunity for five students to travel to Emerald Heights School in Indore, India in the fall of 2019 to attend the Round Square International Conference (tentative dates, including travel: October 1 - October 9). Students from other schools from around the world will be at this conference. The experience will be truly unforgettable! Applicants must be age 16-19 during 2019-2020 (even if you're turning 16 after the conference dates). Total cost for the trip is ~\$3,200; some scholarship is available. Your parents have received information about this opportunity.

There are a few things to consider as you apply to be a delegate. First and foremost, while you are abroad you are acting as an ambassador of the United States and more specifically as an ambassador of The Marvelwood School. This is a position that is not to be taken lightly, as your time with the host school will leave a deep and lasting impression that will impact future trips. While visiting India, you must abide by their laws.
You will write an article for the school's magazine, the Blue and White, upon your return.
You will speak at School Meeting and other events about the experience.
