## Davis High School Community Council Minutes November 7, 2018 6:30 a.m.

Council Chair Shanna Barker welcomed the Council and reviewed the minutes from last meeting. Gregg Laub motioned for approval. Kate Niederhauser seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

The student officers reported on fundraisers they are doing: Sub for Santa, Thanksgiving meal fundraiser, and a food drive by the Key Club.

Shanna Barker encouraged attendance at one of the remaining training sessions.

Mr. Wilkey shared a District memorandum on digital citizenship, dated 21 May 2017. He indicated that the District may be updating the memorandum. The Council is to review the memorandum for discussion next month. The Council discussed the possibility of having an assembly during the 4th term with Collin Kartchner concerning digital awareness.

Mr. Wilkey and Mr. Chapple presented ACT data from the DHS class of 2018. The ACT test scores improved in all 5 areas. Benchmark scores also improved. Maintaining improved scores is a difficult task. It was noted that one of the Community Council goals for 2017 was to improve ACT scores. A big step to maintain the scores is through practice tests. DHS took a practice test the day before. DHS participation seemed high. A canvas course is available to review ACT answers and explanations.

The Council reviewed the Trustland budget expenditures year-to-date. Mr. Wilkey shared a memorandum from the District indicating DHS enrollment was slightly less than the estimated enrollment. As such, the DHS Trustland budget was reduced by \$3823.00.

For next meeting, the Council should review the digital citizenship memorandum.
