Points of emphasis for parents:

- Know what children are posting.
- Frequently facilitate a discussion and ask a question – especially if your child shows a change in behavior
- Don't follow people online with whom you do not have a face-to-face relationship.
- If a specific behavior is not appropriate in person, it is not appropriate online.
- Monitor cell phone/device use in your home. Your child is a minor and under your care.
- When people post online they need to understand the value added to everything they post and the possible consequences (good & bad) of everything posted.
