- 1) School Resource Officer Tabby – this support role has been a great addition to the school. Her current hours are 7 AM – 3:30 or 4:00. Officer Tabby also helps with traffic flow in the mornings and there has already been a noticeable improvement in this area! We are looking forward to seeing all the benefits of having a full time school resource officer.
- 2) In effort to increase our safety, all students, faculty and staff are required to wear their lanyards to school daily. Lanyards are color coded. If a student forgets their lanyard they are assigned a red lanyard for the day. After the first offense, students will receive a detention (equal to 5 days of structured Flex time). If the lanyard and/or ID have been lost, students can purchase a replacement for \$10 from the technology office before or after school.

- 3) Each year the senior students pick one of the Holy Cross Values. This year the students picked "Integrity." The task at hand is no smaller than to help our students become what or who God calls them to be. If one is focused on God's will in your life, integrity is realized.
