Back to School Night

- Freshmen—Cafeteria

Once you pick up the roster, please make your way to the gym.

Please note that parking will not be available in the school parking lot. Parents can park in the Hahnemann Hospital Wood Street Parking Garage. Parking can only be validated if you enter after 5pm.

PowerSchool Parent Log-in Information

This year, Roman Catholic H.S. transitioned from GradeConnect to the PowerSchool Management System. During the first week of school, we worked diligently on getting all of our students logged into the system. The next step in the transition process focuses on providing parents and guardians with log-in instructions so that they can monitor their son's progress. The Parent PowerSchool Access Information will be mailed out this week. These documents will not be distributed at Back to School Night.

Lockers and Locks

On the first day of school, all students were given a locker assignment. Prior to the school year beginning, a lock was placed on every locker to ensure that only the assigned student could access it. Students who have their lock from last year, can turn it into Sr. Jane in the Guidance Office to avoid being charged for the new lock.

PSAT!

The PSAT is scheduled for October 10th! All freshmen, sophomores, and juniors are required to take this assessment. This test is very important, and we ask that you encourage your son to prepare for the PSAT and to take it seriously. The scores on this assessment assist our Guidance Department when working with students during the College Admissions Process. Juniors who take the test are eligible to become National Merit Scholars.
