

Learning Resource Center Students: applying for accommodations on the ACT

You will need to register your student for a test date and pay for a test.

At that time, you indicate your student will be in need of accommodations.

ACT will then send your student a link they are to forward to me. This is where I fill out my pages and upload your testing reports and Accommodation Plan.

Before I can do this, (unless your student is 18 and they can sign) you are to sign the Consent to Release Information to ACT form. It is on the ACT web page, or have your student come pick one up from me.

Test dates for second semester are:

February 10

April 14

June 9 (at Cathedral)

Please register and provide me with the link 5 weeks in advance of the test date. I do the applications in the order I receive them and I can do only a few of these each day due to other responsibilities. For the June test, I need to receive this link before spring break, so **no later than April 6** in order for me to manage large numbers of requests prior to the beginning of May that can allow me to complete these applications in advance of the ACT deadlines.

SAT:

I can apply for these accommodations in advance of your registration for a test. When the student has utilized accommodations regularly, per the College Board guidelines, I give you a signed Consent to Release form I keep on file. I apply and if approved, your student is sent an SSD number to use when registering to show they have been allowed specific accommodations.

March 10th (at Cathedral)

May 5th

June 2nd
