**January 8 - 30 ~ Parents sign up child for Lottery** ~ If you are interested in having your child attend Pre-K at Valley Oaks for the 2019-20 school year, you must add his/her name to the Lottery list. We have only two Pre-K classes on our campus, so space is limited.

### In order to participate in the Lottery Drawing:

- Your child **must be 4 years old** on or before September 1, 2019. If your child will be 5 years old by September 1, they may not enroll in Pre-K.
- Your child **must live in the VOE Attendance area.**
- **Proof of residence will be required** at the time of sign up.
- *Please bring a mortgage statement, tax bill or apartment lease AND a utility bill.*
- You **MUST** come in to the front office to **add your child's name to the List by January 30.**

Priority will be given to children with an older sibling who will be attending VOE, in Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade, during the 2019-2020 school year.

~~~ This does not include siblings that are on an approved transfer.

Pre-Kindergarten at Valley Oaks is a full day program from 7:30-2:30 and is tuition based.\*\*\*

**January 31<sup>st</sup> @ 2:00 p.m. – Pre-K Lottery Drawing**

**February 1 - 28** Notification to Lottery winners for Pre-Registration process. \$50 Registration fee is required to hold space for the fall. Parents of Lottery winners must pre-register by February 28.

**March 1** Parents of children on waiting list contacted for pre-registration.

**March 1 - 29** Parents of children called from the waiting list must pre-register by March 29.

**Parents MUST return in mid-August to complete final registration.**

The Pre-K program is **tuition based** unless the child is eligible for tuition assistance.

\*\*\* Eligibility criteria for PK tuition assistance:

- Limited English Proficiency
- Qualifies due to income
- Homeless
- Parent on active military duty
- Children who have ever been in CPS custody
- Students of parents who are Star of Texas Award recipients
