You will receive your letter to Hogwarts, get sorted into a house, make a wand, learn how to play Quidditch, and participate in different Hogwarts style classes. Come ready to use your imagination and share your ideas about this magical world.

Keyboarding

Keyboarding is the updated term for what used to be typing on a typewriter.

Are you tired of trying to type up your class essays with two fingers? Does it take more time to do that and correct errors than it does to write it by hand? Then try this keyboarding class. Let's face it, you will be typing essays and stories throughout your education. You might as well start practicing now. Touch-typing is the act of using the keyboard without looking at your hands. This class will provide the time and practice for you to learn the keys and the typing skills you will need to write those future essays.

Library Assistant

Students at the end of the six weeks will know and be able to follow library procedures, such as, but not limited to, arrangement and shelving of library materials, use of the library circulation program, and processing procedures for new library the acquisitions. Magic, Pokémon, D&D, and More Card Games

How about some time to research the cards you already own to find their value or discover the most effective way to use them in a game. If so, bring your Magic, Pokémon, D&D, or regular cards and join us third period to share strategies, build decks for play, or challenge each other to epic battles!

Mock Trials

Learn about the court system, argue cases, badger witnesses, cross-examine your peers...I OBJECT...and then maybe spend the last day at the Guthrie Center arguing a case.

Monopoly

Let's get together and play the well-known game that involves both the process of buying land for its development, and also the sale of any undeveloped property. It was also created as a tool to explain the single tax theory and illustrate the negative aspects of concentrating land in private monopolies.

Nine Square (*Active CESIT 7th & 8th Graders requiring PE have priority*)

Enjoy the game that everyone loves to play at lunch but without the line. Come out and have a blast.

Nintendo Labo

Do you enjoy building and engineering? The Nintendo Labo kits contain perforated pieces of cardboard which can be punched out of a specially designed sheet. These cardboard pieces can then be put together to build various toys, which Nintendo calls *Toy-Cons*. We can use the Nintendo Switch to guide the building of your kit, like a digital manual. It's kind of like Lincoln Logs or LEGO, but can interact with the Nintendo Switch in various ways.

Pottery

We will begin with basic properties of clay, techniques to teach you skills to use on more advanced projects. Some of the projects we will do include: Alien planters, wide mouthed fish candy dish, animal masks and hand built vases. This is such an enjoyable class, who doesn't love clay?

Rock Band

Step up and "Rock Out" during this period of fun, excitement, and entertainment. Each band will consist of singers, drummers, guitars, and keyboards.

Sportzapalooza (*Active CESIT 7th & 8th Graders requiring PE have priority*)

Are you a sports fanatic?! Come compete in all kinds of sports, such as flag football, soccer, and kickball just to name a few. Who knows, we may even do some tennis, baseball or track. We will be mixing up the sports each day - anything is possible in Sportzapalooza.

String Art/Zentangles

String Art is simply that. Creating art with string. We will begin by making geometric shapes with string and cardstock. As we progress, we will try using different materials and patterns to create our own personal art. The Zentangle® Method is an easy-to-learn, relaxing, and fun way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns.

Teacher/Office Assistant

Students who want to be office assistants will be expected to assist the staff in clerical duties such as photocopying, filing, running errands, and organizing classrooms. Almost every teacher and the office would love to have dependable and responsible student helpers. You must have a signature from a teacher to be an assistant.

Ted Talk Seminar

Have you ever wanted to know more about a Ted Talk topic, have you wanted to discuss the ideas presented in the talk? Students will watch Ted Talk videos in class and research the topic for the next several days in preparation for a teacher guided discussion. The discussion will be modeled on the Socratic Method; requiring students to participate in a logical and intellectually responsible manner.

Veterinary Medicine

If you are interested in pursuing a career in veterinary medicine this is the CESIT for you! In this class we will discover all sorts of species and how to maintain their health. We will watch videos on how procedures are carried out and what goes on in the day to day life of a vet.

Weightlifting/Four Square *(Active CESIT 7th & 8th Graders requiring PE have priority)*

You will lift weights three days a week and play four square the other two. Bulk it up Cornerstone!

Wild About Animals

In this class we will explore the wide variety of animals and the career paths that lead to working with animals. If you're an animal lover and have a dream of working with animals in the future this is the class for you!

Yoga *(Active CESIT 7th & 8th Graders requiring PE have priority)*

Yoga will help you build strength and flexibility as well as give you a good cardiovascular workout. In this class we will first explore the basic postures and breathing as well as reap the benefits of meditation. As we progress, the yoga postures will be done in a flow series so that students may gain the benefits of a energetic yoga practice. This is a non-competitive, fun and healthy way to get fit and learn to relax the mind.
