JOB GOAL: To maintain warehouse inventory and make deliveries to

cafeterias for New Hanover County Schools.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Follows all rules, policies and procedures of New Hanover County Schools, along with state and federal regulations relevant to the child nutrition department.
- 2. Receives shipments for Child Nutrition; ensures quantities received are as invoiced and in good condition.
- 3. Stores all items received in designated areas.
- 4. Inventories warehouse food and supply stocks monthly.
- 5. Uses provided delivery sheets to pull food and supplies as needed for delivery to schools. Obtains signatures from cafeteria managers for all items delivered, and stores food and supplies as directed.
- 6. Keeps warehouse and truck clean.
- 7. Operates all materials handling equipment including forklifts.
- 8. Loads and unloads trucks.
- 9. Picks up food and/or supplies from vendors on occasion.

- 10. Inspects truck and refrigeration unit daily; reports all problems to the bus garage for repair.
- 11. Monitors temperatures of coolers and freezers in warehouse.
- 12. Operates the gas grill for cook-outs.
- 13. Collects used grease from school sites.
- 14. Performs related duties and responsibilities as requested by the Director or supervisor.
