Starting Salary and/or Grade: NHCS Bus Aide Pay Scale

Evaluation: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the Board and local policy on evaluation of personnel.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Good knowledge of care and discipline of students.
- Ability to deal patiently and effectively with students.
- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with school principals and parents.
- Demonstrates patience and understanding.
- Sincere interest in helping students.
- Sincere interest in student safety.
- Ability to repeat the same hand, arm, finger motion many times; ability to use hand strength to grasp the steering wheel and door; and the ability to move up to 75 pounds at least 25 feet if assigned to an EC bus.
- Ability to exit out of the rear bus door or side door as needed for evacuation.
- Ability to sit, walk or stand; to bend or twist at the neck and trunk while performing duties.
- Vision abilities of close vision, color vision, depth perception and peripheral vision.
- Willingness to work in varying and adverse conditions.
- Good physical condition.
- Ability to follow basic verbal and written instructions.
