1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1 Program Summary

- (Completed) March 1, 2018 Orange HS Increment #1 (Infrastructure Upgrades, Move Relocatable Buildings, Bus Drop-Off, Restroom Renovation Project) (04-116673.1)
- (Completed) February 7, 2018 Villa Park HS Interim Housing (DSA Application #04-116788)

1.2 Program Highlights/Key Milestones

November 8th Approved Board of Education Items

- November 8, 2018, the Board Approved Contract Amendment # 2 for LPA for design services related to reconfiguration of the site parking entrances and overall layout of the traffic flow/circulation plan for the front of the school, to perform the required architectural design and engineering services for a fee of \$97,550. An additional amount of \$9,755 (10%) is being added to cover reimbursable costs and contingency for a total authorization of \$107,305.
- November 8, 2018, the Board approved contract with Site Scan to conduct Topography Ground Survey for Villa Park High School \$6,670 to include the parking lot area to locate property lines at the right of way, locate all utilities (aboveground appurtenances) within detailed survey areas, and survey all top of curb, finish surface, finish grade, and flowline elevations.
- November 8, 2018, the Board approved contract amendment # 3 for HED for Increase the
 design in the amount of \$11,990 for design services related to relocation of the varsity field
 scoreboard, due to changes needed to the field fence and electrical system to accommodate

Procure Electrical System Equipment

- On 11/13/18, the MSA-1 switchgear and last of the (OFCI) electrical equipment was picked up by the Contractor (Swinerton) and transported to the construction site for installation. This completed the OFCI Increment # 1 electrical equipment.
- On 10/11/18, the Board approved the use of CMAS Master Contract Nos. 4-18-51-0061A (B & C) for the purchase of Owner Furnished Contractor Installed (OFCI) Electrical System Equipment for the Villa Park HS STEM Building (Increments #1 & #2), in the amount of \$181,447.56, with an estimated savings of; \$29,939 (using 16.5% GC markup cost).



 The Owner Furnished Contractor Installed (OFCI) electrical equipment bill of materials list for the Canyon HS Science Center was submitted to the Architect for review on 9/21/18, awaiting the Engineer's approval.

Program Management Plan (PMP)

Contractor Pre-Qualification

- Prequalification activity for Orange HS Increment 2 Science Center pursuant to the current bid;
 - 7 Prime Contractors are eligible to bid S1819-001 OHS Sci Center attended mandatory
 job walk and prequalified with audited financials and sufficient single bonding capacity.
- As of 8/31/18, current contractor pregualification includes:
 - 24 Prime/GC's 15 large Prime Contractors are included in this category and able to financially qualify and perform at the level required to bid the large projects at the high schools.
 - There are currently 124 Mechanical / Electrical / Plumbing contractors' (there were 36 MEP's added during the Orange HS Science Center outreach for S1819-001).
 - To date, two marketing efforts for Measure S Program projects included invitations to 382 contractors and 5 plan rooms. Refer to the reoccurring marketing of projects;
 - Each project advertised for bidding will include extensive marketing efforts to maintain a large pool of qualified contractors able to bid Measure S Program projects.
 - Projects are posted to American Reprographics Company (ARC) public plan room, which a large well-known plan room and heavily utilized by school districts for posting of bids.
 - Project general information and a link to ARC is also posted on the District's website, under the Measure S Program.



• Prospective contractors continue to submit pre-qualification applications, which continue to be reviewed by the District and the Program Manager on a rolling basis.

- October 2018 The Board approved the use of CMAS Master Contract Nos. 4-18-51-0061A (B & C) for the purchase of Owner Furnished Contractor Installed (OFCI) Electrical System Equipment for the Villa Park HS STEM Building (Increments #1 & #2), in the amount of \$181,447.56, with an estimated savings of; \$29,939 (using 16.5% GC markup cost).

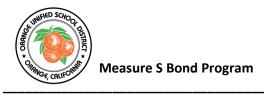

Board of Education Agenda

December 13th Tentative Items:

- Construction Management Master Agreement Amendment # 2 for Balfour Beatty in order to clarify Master Agreement language in terms of the onsite construction trailer rental for the Balfour Beatty staff and the District Inspector of Record offices, District staff is proposing to submit Amendment #2 which allows for the trailer rental to be removed as a contract deliverable (Exhibit E, Item 114) and submitted as a reimbursable cost under the current contract language previously approved in Amendment #1, there is no fiscal impact.
- Construction Management Master Agreement Amendment # 2 for Gafcon in order to clarify Master Agreement language in terms of the onsite construction trailer deliverable (Exhibit E, Item 114), District staff is proposing to submit Amendment #2. The proposed amendment transfers the responsibility to provide offices for the construction management staff and Inspector of Record to the awarded contractor for the science center project and will be included in the hard cost construction bid, there is no fiscal impact.
- Construction Management Master Agreement Amendment # 2 for Cordoba in order to clarify Master Agreement language in terms of the onsite construction trailer deliverable (Exhibit E, Item

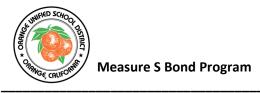




114), District staff is proposing to submit Amendment #2. The proposed amendment transfers the responsibility to provide offices for the construction management staff and Inspector of Record to the awarded contractor for the science center project and will be included in the hard cost construction bid, there is no fiscal impact.

- Recommend the lowest responsive responsible bid for the Orange HS Science Center project (Increment # 2). The bid closed on 11/28/18 and we received five (5) bids by close of bid. It is recommended that the Board of Education Award Bid No. S1819-003 Orange High School Science Center to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, whose bid is within the estimated budget for this project.
- Recommend the lowest responsive responsible bid for the Villa Park HS Interim Housing & Science Center project. The bid closed on 11/30/18 and we received five (5) bids by close of bid. It is recommended that the Board of Education Award Bid No. S1819-002 Villa Park High School Interim Housing Science Center to the responsive responsible bidder, whose bid is within the estimated budget for this project.
- Contract Amendment # 1 for P2S to conduct commissioning for the following systems in the Satellite Kitchen at Orange HS Increment # 1; Split System Indoor Fan Coil Unit (x2); 2. Split System Outdoor Heat Pump (x2); 3. Exhaust Fan (x1), in the amount of \$4,755.
- Contract Amendment # 3 for Harley Ellis Devereaux (HED) to provide architectural and engineering services for Measure S projects at El Modena High School. Superintendent Hansen and District Staff met with HED in October to further discuss the Phase I (Science Center) design services completion process and began planning discussions regarding Phase 2 design. To remain in alignment with the Master Plan for El Modena High School and to stay consistent with concepts developed by the community stakeholder process, HED has proposed to provide conceptual "basis of design" Phase 2 drawings/renderings for a fee of \$28,560. If this contract amendment is approved, HED will present conceptual design drawings to the Board at a later meeting prior to the end of the 2018-19 school year. The Program Manager and District staff have reviewed the proposal and believe the cost to be reasonable. An additional amount of \$2,000 is being added to cover reimbursable costs and contingency for a total authorization of \$30,560. If approved, this request will become an amendment to HED's Architectural Services Master Agreement approved by the Board of Trustees on March 9, 2017.
- Contract Amendment # 3 for LPA, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering services for Measure S projects at Villa Park High School. Superintendent Hansen and District Staff met with LPA in October to further discuss the Phase I (Science Center) design services completion process and began planning discussions regarding Phase 2 design. To remain in alignment with the Master Plan for Villa Park High School and to stay consistent with concepts developed by the community stakeholder process, LPA has proposed to provide conceptual "basis of design" Phase 2 drawings/renderings for a fee of \$76,000. If this contract amendment is approved, LPA will present conceptual design drawings to the Board at a later meeting prior to the end of the 2018-19 school year. The Program Manager and District staff have reviewed the proposal and believe





the cost to be reasonable. An additional amount of \$1,000 is being added to cover reimbursable costs and contingency for a total authorization of \$77,000. If approved, this request will become an amendment to LPA's Architectural Services Master Agreement approved by the Board of Trustees on March 9, 2017.

Contract Amendment # 3 for Lionakis to provide bidding services for the re-bid of Orange HS Science Center (S1819-003). Services include; architectural, interior design, structural engineering, electrical / low voltage, engineering, mechanical engineering, landscape architect. Assumes the same DSA approved plans and specifications used in the original bid package, along with approved addenda, will be used for re-bidding the project, in the amount of \$18,700.

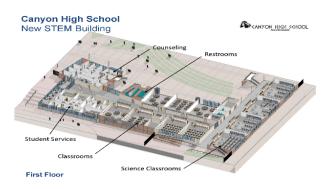

 accommodate the overall changes that will occur as a result of the construction
 schedule for El Modena HS Science Center project.
- As of 11/06/18 the Architect received verbal approval of El Modena HS STEM Building plans (DSA Application #04-117098). This approval was earlier than our anticipated projection.

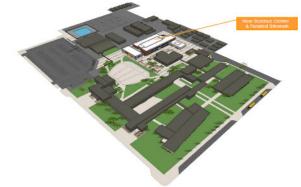
Project Update Increment #2 – Science Center (Design):

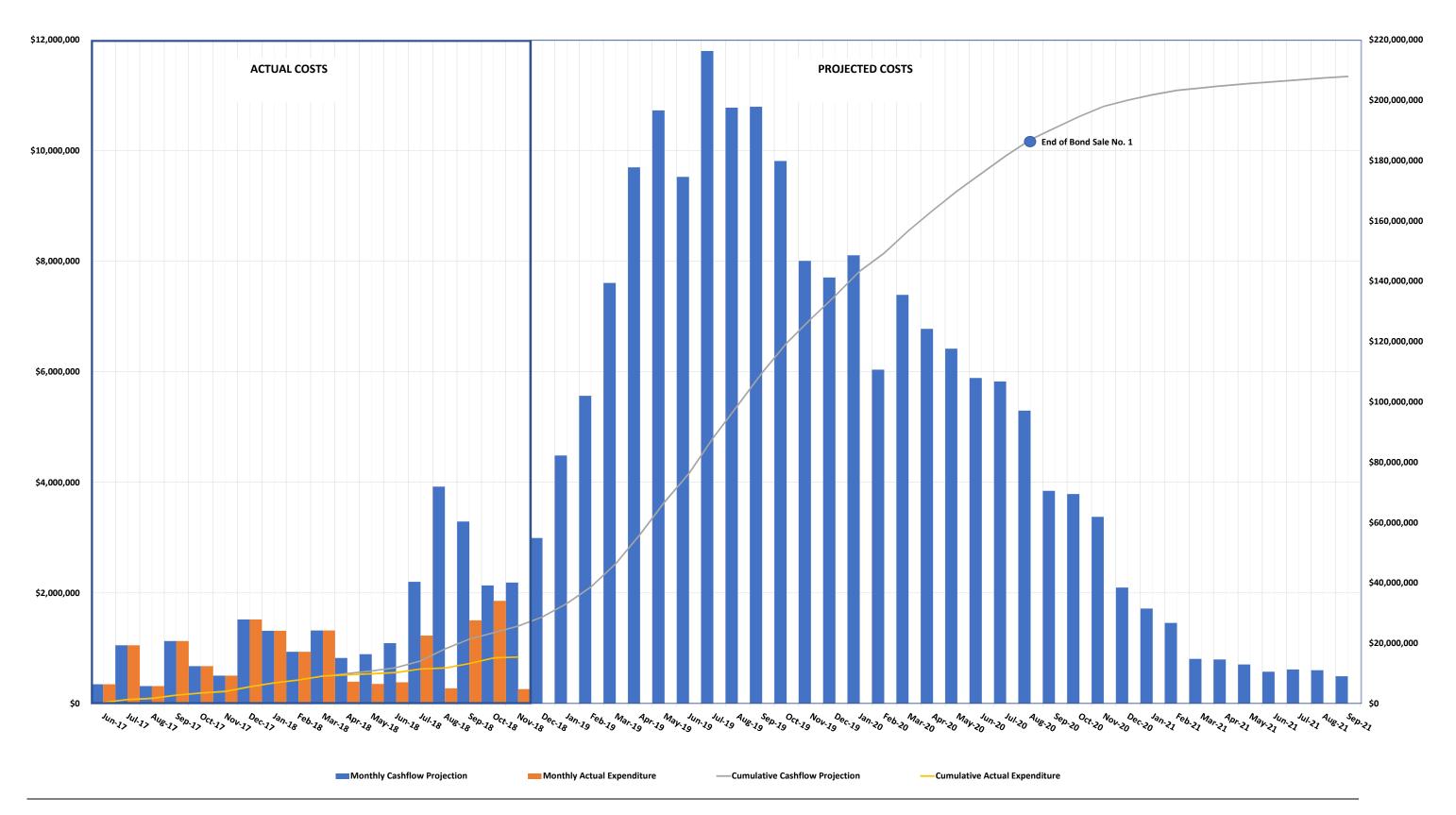

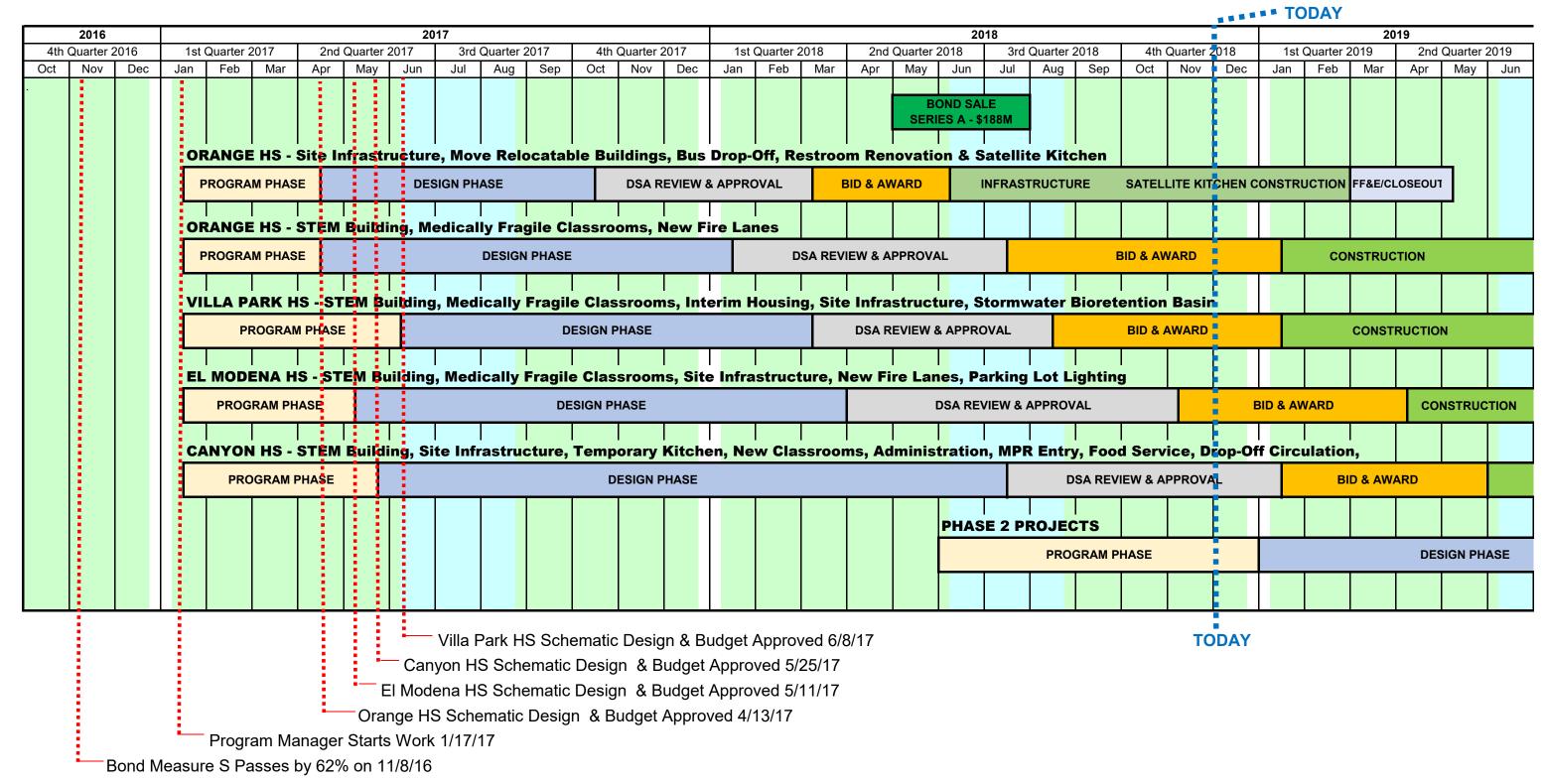

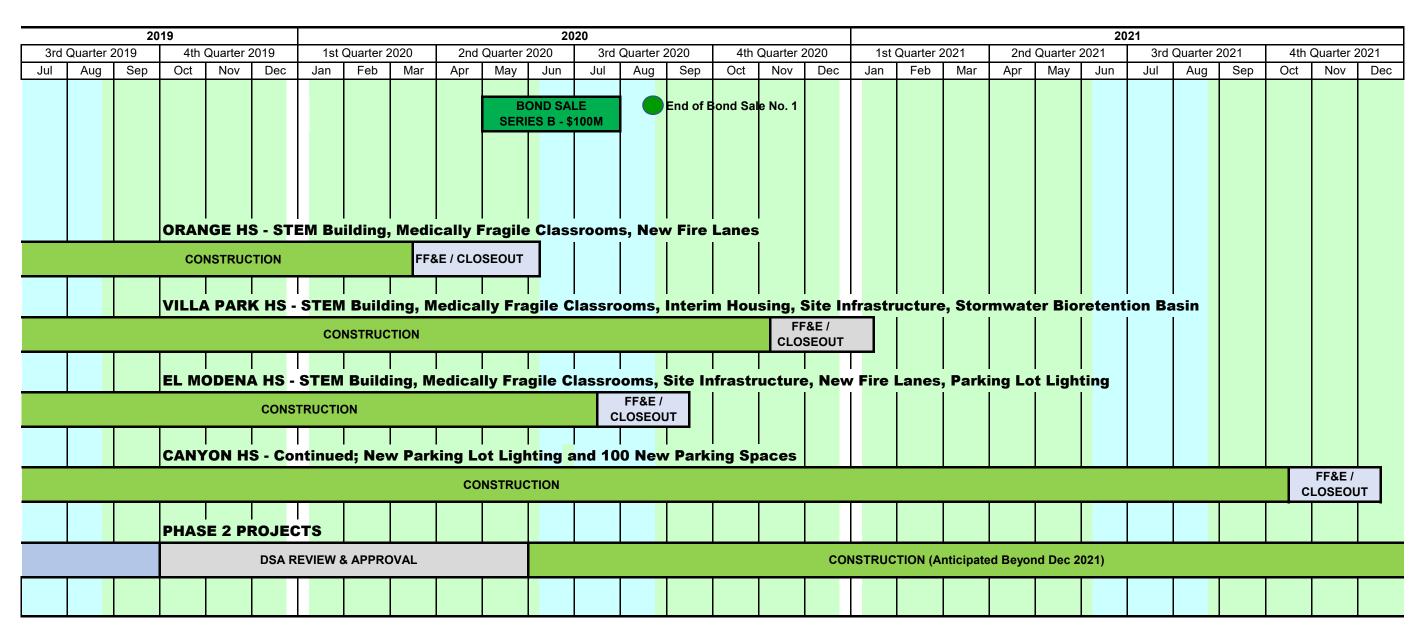
