

SAT/ACT CONCORDANCE TABLE

To convert **SAT to ACT**, find your total SAT score in the SAT column at left. The ACT equivalent for your score will be the number to the right.

Example: A **1330** on the SAT is equivalent to a **29** on the ACT

To convert **ACT to SAT**, find your total ACT score in the right column. The SAT equivalent for that score is the bold number at left.

Example: A **34** on the ACT is equivalent to a **1500** on the SAT
