Overview

The Position

Cardigan Mountain School seeks an experienced and committed educator to serve as a faculty member for the 2018-2019 school year. As a full-time faculty member, you will be called upon to teach, to serve as an advisor to students, to coach multiple athletic seasons and/or to perform comparable non-athletic responsibilities, to participate in the clubs program, to attend meals and help monitor the dining room, and to supervise a dormitory floor.

Responsibilities

Teaching

- Teach three sections (each section meets five times/week for 40 minutes/meeting)
- Attend regular department meetings (i.e., English, mathematics, science, world languages, history, art, PEAKS, leadership) to discuss curriculum and professional development opportunities
- Attend regular team meetings to coordinate curricula and opportunities for cross-curricular initiatives, and discuss individual student progress
- Report regularly on student progress

Coaching

• Coach two seasons (fall/winter/spring) of athletics, including daily meetings throughout the season, and two competition days/week.

Advising

- Meet regularly with individual students to discuss individual goals and progress, and help students to understand and manage their overall workload
- Establish and maintain an ongoing relationship with parents to discuss individual student goals and progress from a holistic perspective

Residential Life

- Oversee a dormitory or dormitory floor, ensuring the safety and health of students in a residential setting
- Attend meals, oversee a table during family-style meals, and monitor the dining room
