Dear Parents and Students,

York Community High School is pleased to offer a summer session of Driver Education **and** Behind the Wheel (BTW) as follows:

REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED STARTING TBD at DOOR 3 at 7:30 am. After TBD Date, registrations will be taken in the Athletic Office. Both the application and check must be turned in to hold a summer spot; only 24 spots available. Applications will be taken in order of when they are dropped off.

Classes Dates: June 10, 2019 thru June 27, 2019
Meeting Location: Monday – Thursday in room S125
Course Fee: \$350 (\$20 additional fee will be required to obtain student permit)

Enrollment Deadline: Friday, May 10, 2019

**** It will be the Parent/Student responsibility to obtain the student permit by going to a local DMV after May 10th but prior to the start of class on June 10th – IF STUDENT PERMIT IS NOT OBTAINED BY THE START OF CLASS ON JUNE 10th THE STUDENT WILL BE DROPPED WITHOUT A REFUND.**

Daily attendance is mandatory. Prior to submitting an application for summer Driver Education and BTW, students should ensure they are able to attend **ALL** 12 classroom and behind the wheel sessions. Strict Illinois laws require a minimum of 30 hours for classroom instruction, 6 hours of driving time, and 6 hours of observation time. Refunds for Summer Driver Education will not be issued after Monday, May 20th.

Summer Drivers Education is a highly condensed, fast paced program. This course demands daily driving practice and content study time outside of the classroom. Enrollment is limited and priority will be given to eligible public and in district parochial high school students along with prioritizing by student birth dates if needed. To be eligible to enroll in summer school drivers education students must be 15 years of age by May 10th, and have passed at least 8 courses during the previous two semesters to enroll in the course.

OBTAINING A STUDENT PERMIT INFORMATION

In an effort to allow students to obtain their permit in a timelier manner and due to students in spring sports/spring commitments student will be eligible to get their permits 1 month prior to the start of the summer school session.

On Friday, May 10th, your child will be eligible to apply at any local DMV for their permit **after** picking up their permit application in the York Athletic Office. All students **MUST** have their permit by the start of class or they will be dropped without a refund. It is recommended all students obtain their permit in a timely manner to allow students driving practice prior to the beginning of class.

In order to obtain a student permit you must have the following items for the DMV:

- Completed permit application
- Check for \$20 made payable to the Secretary of State (NO CASH)
- Corrective lenses for the vision test (glasses/contacts)
- Certified copy of birth certificate

- Photo ID – ex. Student ID
- 2 forms of residency

To prepare for the state license exam and pass with at least 80% students will need to prepare on their own by obtaining a hard copy of the Rules of the Road book at any local DMV or obtaining an online copy of the book at www.cyberdriveillinois.com.

If interested in enrolling please fill out the attached application and submit the appropriate paperwork with fee to the York High School Athletic Office (S115). Once registration is complete students and parents will be emailed a registration confirmation letter prior to the May 10th permit application distribution.
