TUITION PAYMENT INFORMATION

Pay through FACTS. Installment options include:

Twice a year

July and January

Quarterly

July, October, January, April

Monthly

A non-refundable re-registration deposit of \$600 is made through FACTS to hold a student's place for the 2019-2020 school year, and is credited to that year's tuition.

A student is eligible for re-enrollment once the re-registration deposit is received by the Academy. Upon new student registration or re-enrollment, the student's parents/guardians assume the obligation to pay the total tuition for the full academic year, including any fees and expenses incurred during that time. Payments are due on the dates specified above. In the event the student's account is in arrears, either for the current or for any previous school year, the Academy reserves the right, without limitation, to pursue collection of unpaid tuition, including any attendant costs and fees, to withhold academic records, report cards, diplomas and transcripts, and to decline re-enrollment.

Families may add an additional 6% of the base tuition to their tuition payment. This tax-deductible voluntary contribution assists with Faculty/Staff medical benefits.

We endeavor to maintain an affordable tuition and count on the good will and generosity of our parents to give according to their means to our Annual Sustaining Fund.
