The camp is mentored by Dr. Jason Finn, an author, artist, U.S. Fulbright recipient, and Haverford Middle School Seminar teacher, where he spends the school year devising lesson plans where he can wear a wig.

Thank you for taking an interest in advancing your talents in writing this summer. Some of the activities planned include, but not limited to, the following:

A visit to the Rare Book Dept. at the Free Library of Philadelphia or UPenn's Kislak Library

The students will tour one of these world–famous literary treasures, meet with the librarian and view literary gems, such as Gutenberg's Bible, Shakespeare's 2nd folio, first drafts of Dracula and Edgar Allan Poe's "Annabelle Lee".

Experience Center City Philadelphia like never before – as a writer

Relax in the tranquil beauty of Rittenhouse Square, participate in the daily hustle and bustle of urban life, create with Pig Iron Theater Co., stroll among the gloomy and historic graveyards, romantic streets, and modern skyscrapers - all to provide stimulus to your writing.

Meet and talk with professional artists

Discuss the language of photography, art, and drama as you explore different methods to express your writing – screenplay, vignette, monologue, narrative, memoir, etc.

Transportation and Camp Center

Jason Finn will meet all participants at the train station (Suburban Station for R5 or 15th Street Station for the Market-Frankfurt Line) to provide a safe and insightful walk to the day's locale. After each camp day, the participants will be escorted to train or pre-arranged city pick-up spot.
