PLEASE READ THIS FORM COMPLETELY

Returning this form PROHIBITS Lemont High School from using a student's name/photo for any form of publicity.

DO NOT RETURN THIS FORM if you wish for your student's name/ photo to be used for recognition by Lemont High School District 210.

Throughout the year, Lemont High School publicizes the accomplishments of its students and staff, and in doing so, may utilize information pertaining to the student, which is limited to:

- Student's full name
- Grade level
- Parent/guardian names

- Gender
- Birth date and place
- Height/weight for athletic teams
- Photos (individual or grouped with other students/faculty/staff)
- Individual work (poems, artwork, etc.) and/or photos of individual work

This information may be used both in print and on the Internet

Reasons for publicity include, but are not limited to:

- Academic awards (including being listed on the honor roll)
- Honors
- Participation in school-sponsored activities and organizations (including athletics)

Examples of publicity include, but are not limited to:

- District publications (newsletters, annual reports, etc.), videos or website
- Placements in local, regional and national media (print and electronic, including social media)

Note: Lemont High School will not distribute a student's home address or home or cellular phone number to a member of the media. It will be the responsibility of the student to contact the media member if requested for an interview.

Students are encouraged to exercise caution when sharing personal information during an interview with a member of the media.
