4. **President's Report-** (Judy Pincus)
 - A. Concessions for gymnastics & wrestling –
 1. Football season concessions have ended.
 2. Gymnastics concessions made \$2100 over two 12-hour days. Need help with concessions. Please ask friends/spouses for help.
 3. Booster has been asked to take over wrestling concessions. There are 5 events estimated to make over \$1000 each. Discussed wrestling filling out a form for home ec to use their equipment. Mary Bretthauer to fill out form.
