Wayne-Finger Lakes P-TECH School (W-FL P-TECH) welcomes your application. W-FL P-TECH connects high school, college, and the world of work through partnerships with Finger Lakes Community College and regional industries. Our school offers students the opportunity to obtain a college degree and pursue a career in the STEM fields. P-TECH students are provided an advanced education over a multi-year pathway of study leading to an Associate's degree and an exciting and rewarding career. A multi-year (grades 9-14) school and commitment, students start in 9th grade and continue with P-TECH and FLCC for up to six-years. At the beginning of their P-TECH career, students are enrolled in both Regents level and college level courses. At the conclusion of their education, each student receives both their high school diploma and an Associate's degree from Finger Lakes Community College and are prepared for a career.

A successful W-FL P-TECH student: Is motivated by personal success, values learning and solving problems, and has shown the ability to follow through and complete tasks and projects. Thrives with problem-solving activities and project-based learning and demonstrate self-direction and independence. Has high regard and respect for others and are open and accepting of others and their ideas. Demonstrates readiness for Regents level courses as evidenced by success in middle school. Is interested in computers and has some computer experience. Are interested in STEM topics and learning and the real-world applications of math, science, and technology.

Requirements for consideration in the school: the school requires a sincere commitment on the part of the student and family; therefore, our application process requires that the following criteria are met:

Student application requirements:

- Visit the school and take a tour (optional but highly-encouraged).
- Meet with their counselor to discuss his/her application.
- Submit to their school counselor a completed application packet including: student application portion plus personal responses to questions.
- Participate in student interview to be scheduled by W-FL P-TECH representative and home district school counselor.

Parents/guardians application requirements:

- Visit the school and take a tour (optional but encouraged).
- Complete the Parent/Guardian form portion of the application (to be submitted by the student to his or her school counselor).

Counselor application requirements:

- Help set up a tour for the student (and parents/guardians if they choose).
- Complete the counselor recommendation portion of the application and rubric.
- Meet with the student to discuss his/her application.
- Submit completed application on behalf of the student.
- Assist W-FL P-TECH representative with scheduling student interview(s).
- Work with W-FL P-TECH counselor on student records transfer if student is accepted.

Math and ELA teachers application requirements:

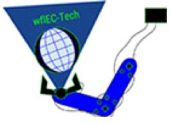
- Complete the teacher recommendation portion of the application and submit to student's counselor.
