With your continued belief in a Trinity-Pawling education, we will move forward, to lead a course through a changing educational landscape, and ensure a strong future for upcoming generations of promising young men.

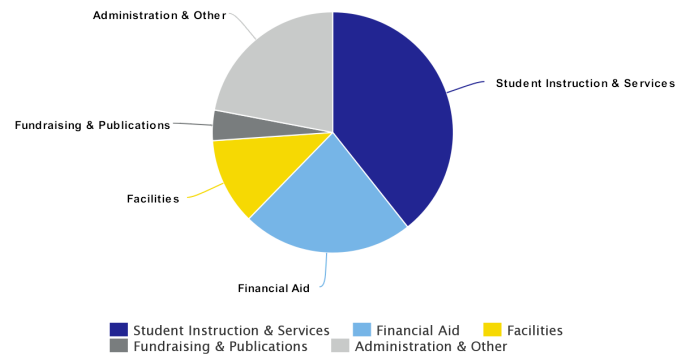

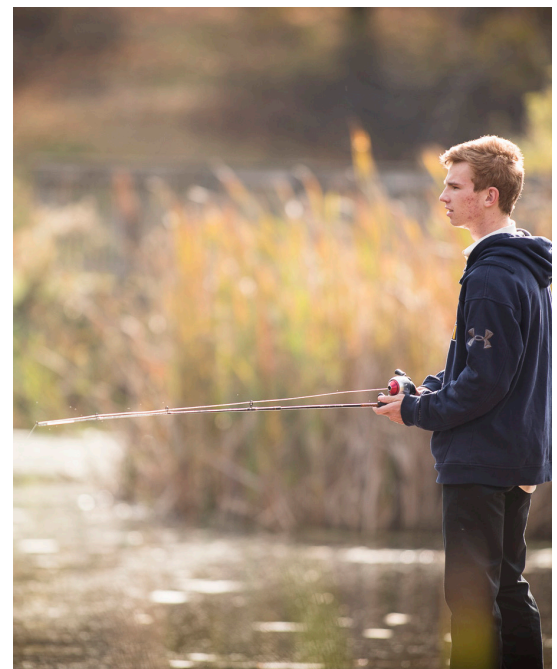
