

## Rhetoric 101 and 102 Dual Credit Enrollment Checklist

### Prerequisites:

- Students must be in academic good standing. Students who have taken a JJC class prior to this time and has received a “D” or an “F” are not eligible to enroll in district dual credit classes.
- It is strongly suggested that students meet with their high school counselor to discuss their academic schedule and review NCAA eligibility and transfer credit options where applicable.
- Students must successfully complete English 3
- Students must achieve an SAT English and reading score of 480, an ACT English and reading score of 19, or complete placement testing at JJC using the ACCUPLACER program (Reading: 80, English: 7).

### Requirements:

- Complete and sign Academic Dual Credit Student Approval Form; submit to counselor during course registration.
- Apply to JJC online; submit printed completed application to counselor.

- Verify placement scores or take ACCUPLACER placement exam; submit a copy of results to counselor (students can use spring SAT score to qualify).
