

**Student Neighborhood Access Program  
Syracuse Junior High School 2018-2019**

Our mission is to find the safest routes for our student's, to and from Syracuse  
Junior High School

**Location:** Syracuse Junior High School- 1450 South 2000 West Syracuse, Utah.

**EXISTING TRAFFIC CONTROLS**

1. Traffic light at 1000 West and Antelope Drive (1700 South).
2. Traffic light at 2000 West and Antelope Drive (1700 South).
3. Traffic light at 700 South and 2000 West
4. Hawk System between the Junior High and the Elementary School for pedestrian safety

**ESTABLISHED SCHOOL ZONES**

**Reduced Speed School Zones**

- Marilyn Dr. (1475 W.) and Antelope Drive (1700 South): Flashing light and crossing guard only when Elementary in transit.
- 2000 West and approximately 1500 South (crossing from the front of Syracuse Elementary and the south side of Syracuse
- Junior High).

**School Crosswalk Zones**

- 2000 West and Antelope Drive (1700 South). Two Crossing Guards at intersection.
- Banberry Dr. and 700 South
- Antelope Dr. and Doral Dr.
- 3000 W. and Antelope Dr.
- Antelope Dr. and Bluff Rd

**Narrow School Routes**

- 3000 West; from 700 South to 1200 South.

**School Bus Loading Zone**

- School Buses enter the school at the North end of the school property. The buses turn South and park in a double row parallel to the sidewalk in the north sector of the school parking lot.

**Parking Areas, Student Drop Off**

- A parking lot on the south side of the school accommodates parents who need to drop their student(s) off or pick them up at
- school.
- The front red curb is for Police and Emergency vehicles only and is not a parking area.
- The front parking lot is intended for Faculty and Staff with an exit-only in the center portion.

### **Hazards and Areas of Concern:**

- Bluff Road to 1700 South. No sidewalk but wide shoulder on east side.
- No sidewalk at Bluff (North side) heading East on 1700 South to 2500 West.
- Parent drop off zone is in the south. If parents choose to drop students off on 2000 West in front of the school, they should avoid entrances and exits. Students should not cross through the parking lot in front of and between cars and busses.
- Crossing zones and crosswalks need to be painted and signage updated for Visibility.

### **WALKING ROUTES**

#### **Quadrant I (North West)**

Students living between 2000 to 2500 West and 700 to 1500 South will:

- Travel internal sidewalks to 1175 South or 1275 South to 2000 West and south to school. OR 2200 West and 1450 South to access school through back playing fields.

Students living 1200 to 1700 South and 2500 to 2700 West will:

- Travel north to 1200 South, go south on 2500 West, travel east to 2000 West and south to SJH.

Students living 2000 to 2925 West and 200 to 700 South will:

- Travel on surface streets to 700 South, then east on north side of street to 2000 West and 700 South. Cross with light and south to school.

Students living 700 South and 3000 West will:

- Use western walk boundaries accessing internal sidewalks to Bluff Road and 3000 West Trail head, going south on the trail to 1700 South the east on north side to 2500 North to 1450 South and east to school.

#### **Quadrant II (North East)**

Students living between 200 to 1700 South and 1000 to 2000 West will:

- Use internal subdivision sidewalks traveling to 1525 West or Banberry Drive to Dallas Street (1240 South) then west ward to 1350 South. Walk South and cross at the crosswalk to Syracuse Junior High School.
- Those students on the East side of 1000 West should cross at the crosswalk at 1290 South, then access Dallas Street (1240 South) westward to 1350 South crossing to Syracuse Junior High at the proposed crosswalk.

**NOTE:** There are currently no continuous sidewalks on the South side of 700 South between 1000 West and 2000 West. There is a sidewalk on 700 South between Banberry Dr. and 2000 West, but these cross driveways for the Syracuse High School. Also, no sidewalks exist on the East side of 2000 West from 700 South to 1175 South. Due to these circumstances and the amount of traffic on 1000 West (SR 108), 1700 South (Antelope Dr.) and 2000 West, we propose internal subdivision travel to and from school.

### **Quadrant III (South East)**

Students living 1700 to 2125 South and Allison Way will:

- Travel to Allison Way (1525 West), then North to 1700 South, crossing at crosswalk. Travel west to 2000 West then North to crossing guard.
- Students living 1700 to 2700 South west of Dahl Lane (1525 West) to 2000 West to 2175 South and 2000 West will access internal sidewalks to 2000 West then proceed north through intersection to crossing guard

### **Quadrant IV (South West)**

Students living south of 1700 South, between 3000 West and Bluff Road will:

- Travel west to 3000 West, then north to 1700 South, then east to 2000 West, cross to school.
- Students living south of Craig Lane to 2500 South and Bluff Road to 2000 West will:
- Travel east to 2000 West, then north to 1700 South, then north to crossing guard.

Students living south of Bluff Road approximately 3000 South, west to 2700 West will:

- Travel to 2700 South (narrow access route) to round-about, cross to 2000 West.
