Orange Unified School District offers two preschool programs for children who are ready to begin the transition from a home or daycare environment.

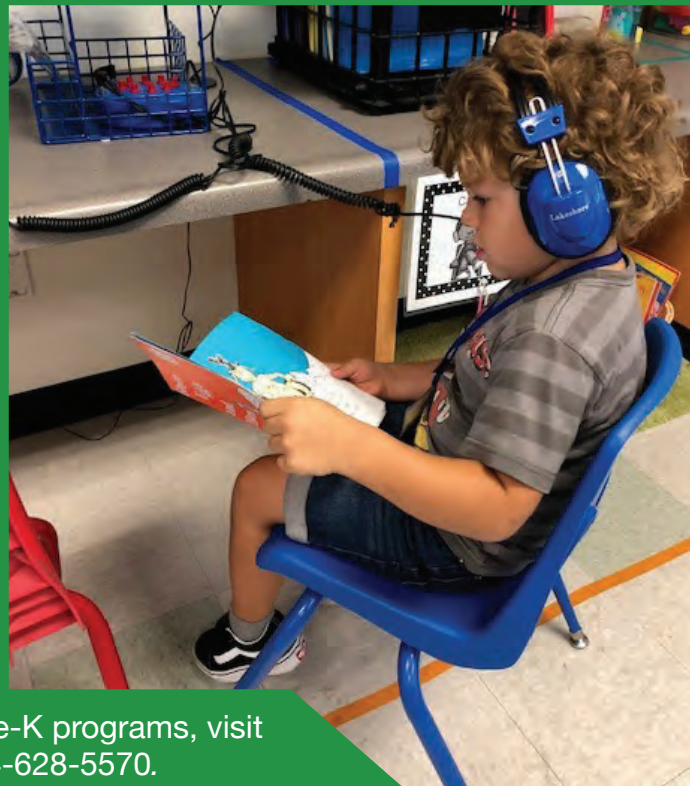

Preschool is the first transition a child makes from the security of the home to the greater arena of school. Special attention is addressed toward achieving a warm, sensitive, safe environment for your child. We recognize that the developmental stages of all children vary. OUSD Preschool (CDC) gets your child ready for kindergarten.

Teachers present a well-developed curriculum that is organized around the following basic skill areas:

- Social-Emotional development
- Early literacy skills (rhyming, letter knowledge and sounds)
- Early writing skills, print awareness, children's literature, and early math and science skills presented in a nurturing and developmentally appropriate environment
- Early math skills

OUSD CDC is an integral part of the school community. Particular attention is focused on parents, teachers and children working in partnership to make preschool an enjoyable and exciting educational opportunity. Communication between teachers, parents and children is a high priority. Formal and informal opportunities will be provided so that parents and teachers can exchange information to ensure the success of each child.

The OUSD Early Learning Center offers two preschool programs for children, ages 0-5 years old: The Learning Link program (three elementary school sites) and the State subsidized program (eight elementary school sites).

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OUSD's State Preschool Program provides part-day preschool for eligible 3- and 4-year-olds at eight elementary school campuses. This is a State subsidized program and families are selected based upon eligibility criteria. Our classes run from 8-11 a.m. or 12-3 p.m., and are taught by teachers with child development permits. We focus on the California Preschool Learning Foundations and use the Social Emotional Foundations for Early Learning (SEFEL) model to teach students the social emotional skills necessary for their success. Don't miss out on this FREE experience for your 3- or 4-year-old child!

In addition to preschool opportunities, our Early Learning Center provides a Learning Link program to the community. Learning Link is a "Parent and Me" program for children 0-5 years old, that focuses on teaching parents how to teach their young children. Through this program, families have a safe, educational and fun environment for their children to learn and play. Come check it out! The class is taught by a teacher with a child development permit and supported by School Readiness Nurses. Parent trainings, referrals and screenings are provided. A donation of \$1 per visit is appreciated.
