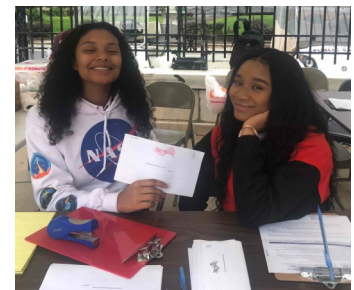

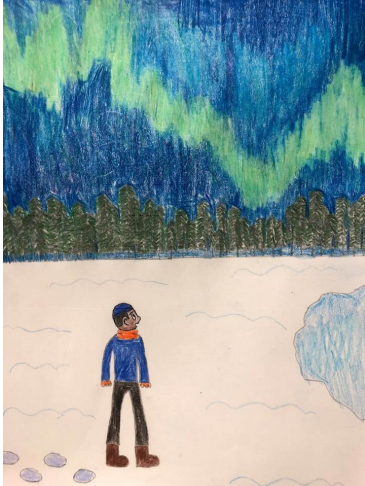


Creative Expression Class Meets Co-Authors

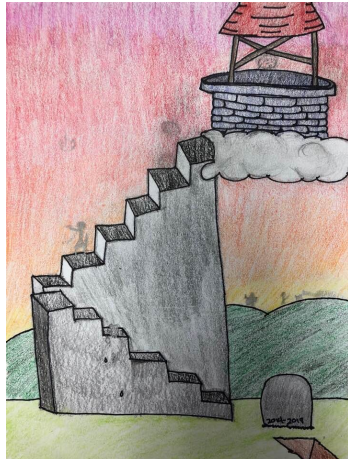

Political Current Events: The Kavanaugh Hearings

On July 9, 2018, President Trump nominated Judge Brett Kavanaugh to the Supreme Court. In order for Judge Kavanaugh to be appointed a chair on the Supreme Court, he needed to be voted on by the Senate.

Before the Senate voted on Kavanaugh, he was accused of three accounts of sexual misconduct. The FBI carried out an investigation on the sexual misconduct allegations.

Throughout the month of September, the Senate and the world heard the testimony of several witnesses against Kavanaugh (both formally in hearings and informally in social

media and on the news). Even though people came forward to tell their impressions of Kavanaugh, he was appointed to the Supreme Court by a Senate vote of 50-48.

On October 8th, Judge Kavanaugh was sworn in by President Trump for the position of Associate Justice of the Supreme Court. As a result, there were many protests across the nation regarding the decision made by the Senate.

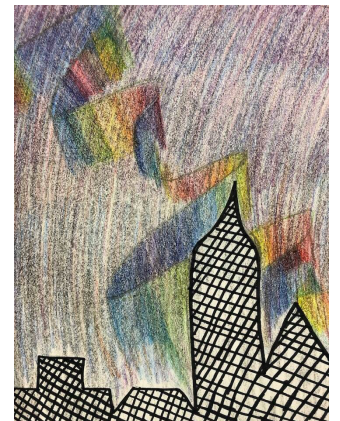

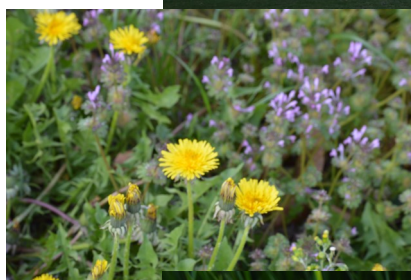

Many people also have suspicions about him as well including Sergeant Doakes, who constantly questions Dexter's every move. *Dexter* is currently streaming on Netflix.

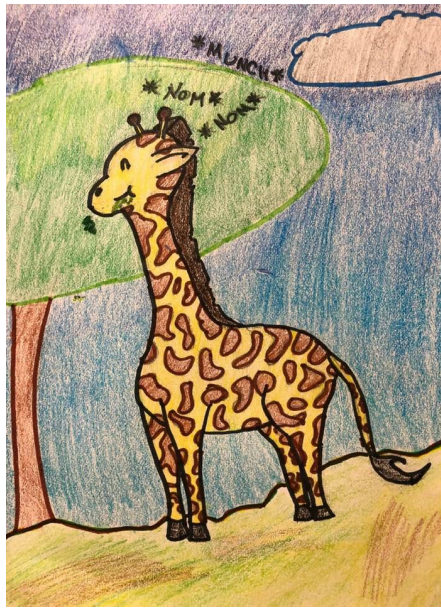

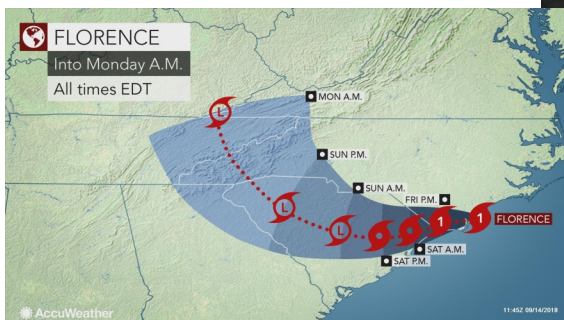

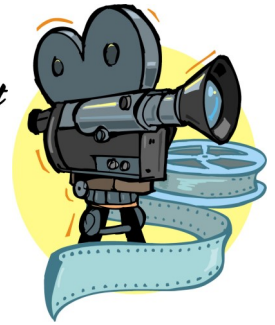
French Trip to the Rodin Museum

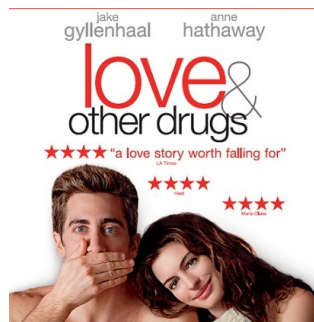
Love and Other Drugs

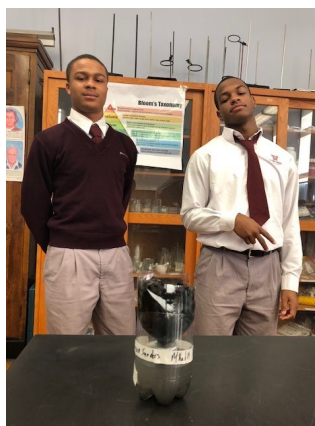
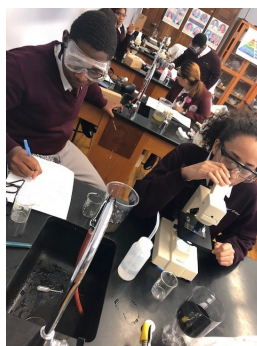

Biology Students Create Filters

The week of Oct. 15th, Ms. Monet Thomas-Anderson Biology students investigated the unique properties of water by creating filters to filter "dirty" water.

Ms. Monet Thomas-Anderson presented the students with common natural resources (pebbles, activated charcoal, sand, coffee filters, etc). Students researched the best products to use then constructed their own filters using a plastic bottle and the natural resources. The students were given a limited amount of resources and had to test the turbidity, pH, and presence of microorganisms to determine the effectiveness of their filters.

K+S: Mean but loving

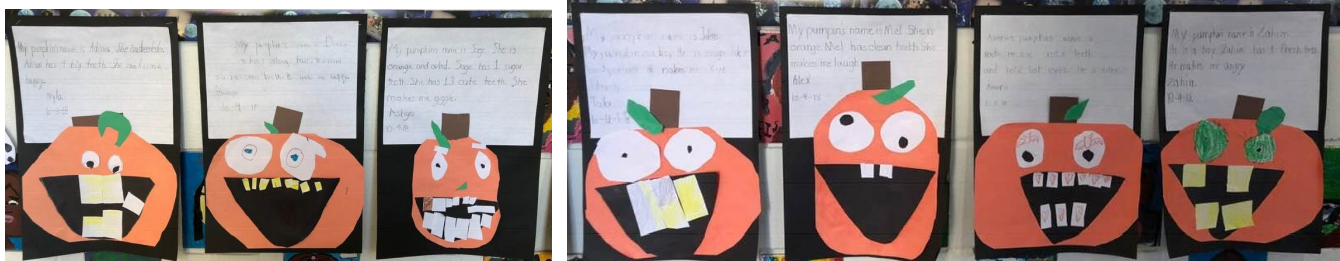
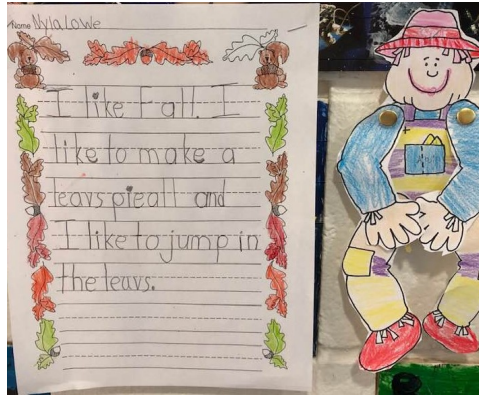
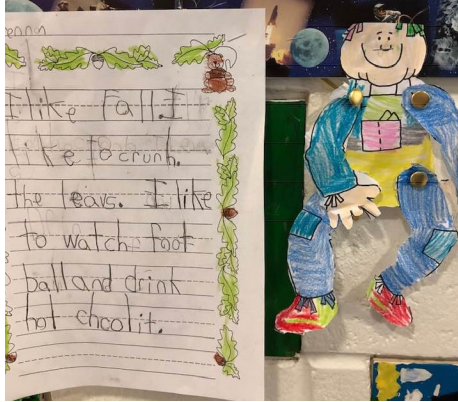

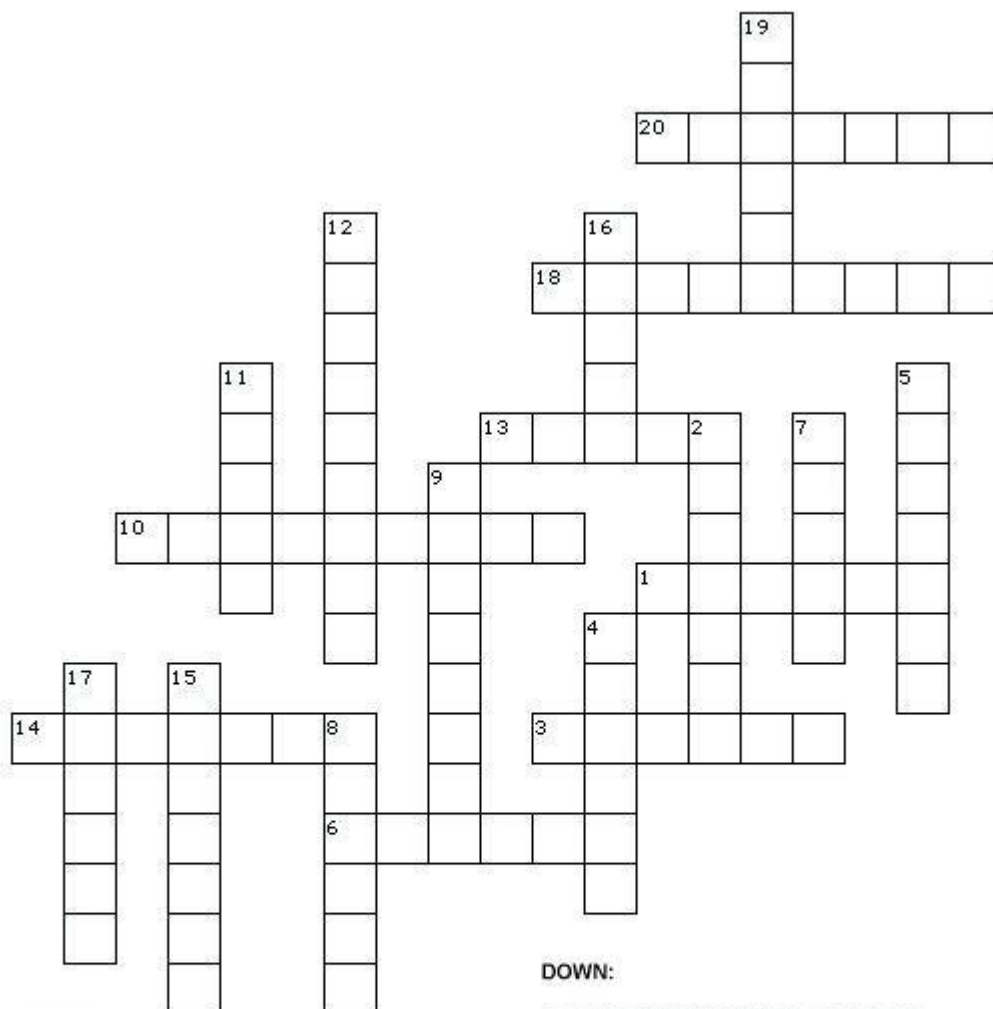
