## ATTENTION!

### NEW IMMUNIZATION REGULATIONS!

#### Kindergarten (multiple dose series)

- 4 doses tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (1 dose after 4th birthday) (DTap, dTP or DT, Td)
- 4 doses of polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday, unless the 3rd is after 4th birthday)
- 2 doses measles, mumps and rubella
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chicken pox)

#### 7th Grade (single dose series)

- 1 dose tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) on the first day of 7th grade
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate (MCV#1) on the first day of 7th grade

#### 12th grade (multiple dose series)

- 1 dose of MCV #2 on the first day of 12th grade. If one dose was given at 16 years or older, that shall count as the 12th grade dose.

#### All students K-12 (multiple dose series)

- IPV#4 (polio) after the 4th birthday unless the 3rd dose is after the 4th birthday

**PLEASE NOTE: All immunizations are due prior to the start of school. If no proof of immunizations is on file, for single doses series, student will be excluded the first day of school and for multiple dose series, student will be excluded on the fifth day of school. Those lacking proof of the necessary vaccines must meet with the school nurse to develop a plan prior to the start of school which includes a copy of the Medical Certificate form with your physician's signature. Uninsured and underinsured students can visit one of the commonwealth's state health centers or local health departments to get the required vaccines. Please call 1-877-PA-HEALTH.**
