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## Social Worker Focus – Sleep Tips

Hello Briarwood Families,

As we get back into the groove of second semester, I wanted to share some information on sleep. Many times when our children are struggling it can be as simple as a lack of adequate sleep. Here are some tips from Children's Mercy Hospital regarding sleep and the amount needed. I hope 2019 is finding you happy and healthy! As always feel free to contact me if I can be of any help.

### Sleep tips

Help your kids do their best by helping them get the right amount of sleep. A lack of sleep can leave kids feeling cranky, clumsy, forgetful, sluggish, or even hyperactive. Follow these simple tips to help your kids get a good night's sleep.

- Allow time for plenty of exercise during the daytime – at least one hour of physical activity a day
- Encourage kids to go to sleep and wake up at the same time each day
- Avoid caffeinated drinks, especially after 2 p.m.
- Turn off television, video games, cell phones and other screens at least 1-2 hours before bedtime

### Why sleep is important for kids

- Helps them feel prepared for the next day
- Helps their tissues, muscles and bones grow
- Helps keep their immune systems healthy (which helps to fight illness)
- Allows their brains to sort and store information
- Makes it easier for them to think, focus, remember and solve problems
- Restores their energy to be active during the day

### Sleep recommendations by age

- 3-5 year olds need 11-13 hours of sleep
- 5-12 year olds need 10-11 hours of sleep
- 13-17 year olds need 9-10 hours of sleep



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## ***Food Service – Did You Know?***

**Do you know what makes a school meal?** Students must choose a full portion of at least three of the five components to receive a full school lunch and at least one component must be a 1/2 cup of fruit or vegetable. Components include entrée, grain, fruit, vegetable, and milk. There are unlimited (single trip) fruits and vegetables available, except for juice and potatoes. Please help by encouraging your student to take what they want, but eat what they take in order to reduce waste. Remember milk is offered, but not required to be taken.



Don't forget – if your child receives free or reduced meals, they are eligible for one breakfast and one lunch per day as part of this benefit. All breakfast and lunch meal choices are available for all students regardless of eligibility status. **The school breakfast menus, lunch menus, and other nutrition information are available on the district's website <https://www.smsd.org/about/departments/food-service>**
