

Meadow Breeze Day Camp Parent Facts Sheet – 2019

Meadow Breeze Day Camp adheres to the policies and procedures mandated by the Lexington Board of Health.

Camp Season	The camp season consists of eight sessions from June 24 - August 16. Each session is Monday through Friday, except Session 2, in which there is no camp Thursday, July 4 or Friday July 5 . Enroll a camper for one session or for any combination up to all 8 sessions.

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Payment Policy	<p>A \$50 deposit for each week is required at the time of enrollment and a child is not considered registered and the spot not secured until the deposit is received. Payment options include: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or a check mailed to camp. All checks should be made payable to Meadow Breeze Day Camp. All other payments are due according to the schedule below. Any cancellations to registered sessions incur cancellation fees. Cancelations must be received 10 days prior to start date for a refund. There is no refund if a camper attends any part of a week. Payment is the responsibility of the person registering the applicant. Medical Examination And Forms	No camper will be allowed to attend camp until the camp medical supervisor receives a completed camp Physician's Form, as per State Law mandates. An up-to-date (less than two years old) physical with the doctor's signature is acceptable in lieu of the doctor filling out the Physician's Form. If applicable the Asthma Action Plan Form and Food Allergy Action Plan Form must be submitted along with the Physician's Form. All medicals forms need to be turned in by May 15. All medical forms can be downloaded from the camp website.
Additional Forms	Climbing Wall Liability Release Form must be completed and signed before campers will be permitted to participate on the rock wall.
Equipment	Campers should wear clothes suitable for physical activity, including close toed shoes . Campers should bring a towel, swimsuit, and sunscreen. Cell Phones, tablets and card games are not allowed to be brought to camp.
Camper Drop Off & Pick Up Protocol	Campers not signed up for extended day must be dropped off NO EARLIER THAN 8:45 AM and picked up in their meeting rooms NO LATER THAN 4:00 PM . Campers may not wait in the office or the parking area at any time. Campers who arrive before 8:45 or are still at camp after 4:00 will be assigned to extended day care in the gym and the appropriate fees will be charged. Photo I.D. needed to pick up campers. Parents picking up their children from camp need to park in lined parking places. Please observe the 20 mph speed limit on Bartlett Ave.
Extended Day Care	Extended Day Care is for parents that need extended camp hours. Campers are assigned to staff in the Activity Center where fun activities are offered. Sessions are available by the week, Monday-Friday (no partial weeks). Campers may not be signed up for 7am and 6:15pm. Pick up and drop off is in the Activity Center. A parent late for pick up twice in the same week will be charged \$10.00. A camper picked up after 6:15 pays a \$1.00/minute late fee. Schedule Includes	Archery/Tennis: Campers learn and improve basic skills through games and instruction. Ball Games: Age appropriate ball and strategy oriented team games. Arts and Crafts: Campers make arts and craft projects. Necklace beads, fuse beads and gimp are favorites here. Creatives: Scavenger hunts, drama, music, nature study, kid's books, and/or storytelling three days each week. Themes (such as Honesty, Fairness, Leadership) are two days each week during this activity period. Elective: The counselor decides and leads the activity with input from the kids. Examples include group project, field games, group games and quiet play, whatever the kids will enjoy. Free Time: Pool/Gym/Rock Wall and selected electives. Kids choose an activity. This is a time to play, where kids can do things they like in a well supervised but less structured environment. GaGa: A game played inside and outside a wooden hexagon frame using a tennis ball. Players keep active. Rock Wall: Climbing wall in gym with a variety of routes to the top. Beginner through advanced. Sports Skills: Campers learn sport skills and strategy through clinic style games and drills. Swimming: Water Safety Instructors and Lifeguards teach American Red Cross skills - 30 minutes in the water daily. Snacks: Camp provides a morning and afternoon snack for all campers. Any campers signed up for extended day should bring additional snacks if needed. Lunch: Lunch and cold beverages are provided by the camp in the dining hall. Please check our website for information regarding the menu.
Other Information	The Private Lessons registration for swim and tennis are instruction in addition to what is being offered during the camp day. Private lessons are held after regular camp hours at an additional cost. Everyone is expected to participate in all scheduled camp activities. Swimming lesson exclusions during the regular camp day are granted on a very limited basis.
