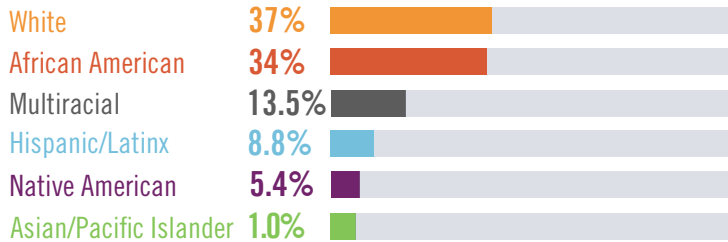

At Grimes Elementary, we believe in educating and nurturing the whole child throughout his or her learning and growth journey. Creating high-quality learning experiences means educating the whole child by meeting his or her social, emotional, and academic needs. Social and emotional learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults acquire and effectively apply the knowledge, attitudes, and skills necessary to understand and manage emotions. With strong social and emotional skills, our students will be able to set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. We envision our school community as an inclusive place that cultivates safe, joyous, caring, and intentional learning environments for adults and students.

## Building powerful relationships with Tribes

Our students start the day with community circles that provide opportunities for students and teachers to come together and build the strong and trusting relationships that are foundational to great learning experiences. We use the Tribes curriculum where students and teachers work together to achieve learning through attentive listening, mutual respect and appreciation, collaborative goal-setting, progress monitoring, and problem-solving. Through Tribes, our students feel included and appreciated by peers and teachers, are actively involved in their own learning, and have positive expectations from others that they will succeed.
