GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

House Bill 1476 mandates that all students beginning with the Class of 2014 must show competency in 14 areas of Personal Financial Literacy. Evidence of student completion will be submitted to the district office where it will be documented on the student's official transcript. Edison Preparatory School requires students to complete these self driven online modules through either of the following courses: Algebra II, Pre AP Algebra II, or Intermediate Algebra. Students MUST be completed with the financial modules by mid December proceeding the senior year.

Periodic electronic monitoring will be conducted to assure students are progressing appropriately. The school does provide students the opportunity to access computers and can modify curriculum if warranted. Particular opportunities will not be available to students that have not met this requirement. Examples include but are not limited to the following: schedule change requests, eligibility for school related activities/functions, involvement in school related activities/functions, graduation.
