The sponsorships include full camp tuition and reimbursement of air-fare and associated travel expenses.

The SAME offers the following unique series of engineering camps designed for High School students interested in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM):

- **SAME/U.S. Army Camp: June 9-15, 2019 in Vicksburg, MS**
- **SAME/U.S. Air Force Academy Camp: June 26 – July 2, 2019 in Colorado Springs, CO.**
- **SAME/U.S. Air Force Camp: July 15-20, 2019 at Scott Air Force Base, IL**
- **SAME/U.S. Navy Camp: June 23-29, 2019 at Port Hueneme, CA.**
- **SAME/U.S. Marine Corps Camp: June 23 – 29, 2019 at Camp Lejeune, Jacksonville, NC.**

These camps are world-class and feature an impressive record of producing thousands of engineers and STEM leaders. They provide a challenging and fun experience for students interested in exploring STEM skills and careers. Campers gain a sense of what it takes to become a STEM professional and what options exist to explore that interest from high school to college and beyond. Each camp has a unique curriculum that generally features hands-on activities conducted in a competitive environment that promote teamwork, leadership, project management, and problem solving.
