List your sources in alphabetical order (by author or title, whichever comes first).

**Reference—Database**

Information from a Database is varied in format. Treat the information as if it were an original printed source (magazine article, report, book, newspaper article, review, etc.) adding the online retrieval information. Name of the online database is not necessary.

**Databases offer online articles. See also: Magazines & Newspaper sheets.**

**Authors:** Friscolanti, M., & Lunau, K [Use Hanging indent i.e. indent line 2]

[If no author is named, place the title of the document in the author position]

**Date of publication:** (2014, Mar. 24). [If no date, use: (n.d.)]

**Title or description of document:** *The winter that ruined everything.* [In italics]
