

MOOC Personal Finance Online

This class is taught as an entry-level collegiate course, online. This means that the majority of the responsibility is on the student to learn and test over the material. There is no (specified) class period for students to sit and do their studying and assignments – they are to manage this on their own. Time management is a core concept taught. The teacher is available at all times for help, for questions, for concerns, for anything that students need assistance.

Spring 2019 Class Periods open to come in anytime to work and study: 1st and 2nd Block

There are some guidelines we will abide by and agree upon:

- Teacher planning period (times will be given to you)
 - If you have same open block and need a place to plant yourself to work (either on Personal Finance or other subjects) – you are welcome to hang out and study
 - Bring snacks (as long as you clean up)
- Communication
 - Primarily through email (**personal.finance@tcsedu.net**) also angela.pendergraff@tcsedu.net
 - Check your email regularly – it is your responsibility. I send info/updates/changes/etc, you don't read – possible zeros to be obtained
 - I'm **IN** the building. Come see me.
 - Don't be afraid to ask questions
- Pass/Fail
 - Course is pass/fail
 - Must pass the class with overall 94% (can only fail 3 assignments)
 - Pass rate on individual assignments is **70% and above**
 - May redo assignments (in a timely manner) that are below 70% to bring up score
 - May work ahead
- Assignment deadlines
 - Deadlines will be adhered to (assignments are due at 11:59pm on evening of due date)
 - Screen shots and pdf copies will be taken of all scores
 - **Third** negligent assignment results in LOSS of “open period”
 - Fourth negligent assignment results in failure of class
- Contact with Parents
 - Upon your second ‘missed assignment’, a call will go home alerting your parents of your status
 - Don't make me call home
 - Don't make me ground you to the classroom
 - Don't fail yourself
