



**TUITION AND FEES

2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR**

Tuition covers all basic educational expenses including:

- Lunch and snacks prepared by Bon Appetit Management Company
- Technology: OES has a 1:1 device program in most grades. The school issues a device to each student in grades 6 through 9 for use during the school year.
- Most experiential education and school field trips
- Most sports participation fees (Grades 6-12)
- School supplies for students in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 5.

**NON-TUITION EXPENSES**

- Extension (Pre-K to Grade 8) – available after school to 6pm; rates available Summer 2019
- School Bus service – rates based upon bus routes and available Summer 2019
- Laptop purchase (Grades 10-12 only) – each student is required to provide their own laptop
- Textbooks (Grades 6-12)
  - Middle School – estimated \$100-200/year
  - Upper School – estimated \$300-500/year
- Winterim Trips (Grades 9-12 only) – local, no fee options are available
- Health Insurance (International boarding students) – annual premium of \$2,260
