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SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Dunlap High School is a comprehensive, four-year senior high school with approximately 1,300 students. It is located in the northwest corner of Peoria County in the town of Dunlap, IL. Dunlap High School Community Unit School District #323 serves students from Dunlap as well as part of northern Peoria.

FACULTY

The Dunlap High School staff consists of 81 certified personnel, including five counselors and two assistant principals. Over 63% of this staff holds a master's degree or higher and the student to teacher ratio is 21:1.

SCHOOL YEAR ORGANIZATION

The school year consists of four quarters, each nine weeks long. Classes meet five days per week for approximately 49 minutes each day during two 18-week semesters. Students can enroll in up to eight class periods.

GRADING AND CREDIT

Dunlap High School utilizes a 4.0 unweighted grading scale. Final grades are issued at the completion of each semester, and are calculated using a combination of quarter (40%) and final exam (20%) grades. G.P.A. and class rank are calculated at the completion of each semester.

SPORTS AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Dunlap High School is a member of the IHSA, and the Mid-Illini Conference. The school offers 22 different sports teams, including 41 teams for boys and girls. The teams compete at the Freshman through Varsity level. The student-athletes who maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher are named Mid-Illini Scholars. The class of 2018 boasts 93 scholar athletes. In addition to athletics, DHS also has upwards of 40 clubs that students can join.

Graduation Requirements

21 units of credit are required for graduation from Dunlap High School.

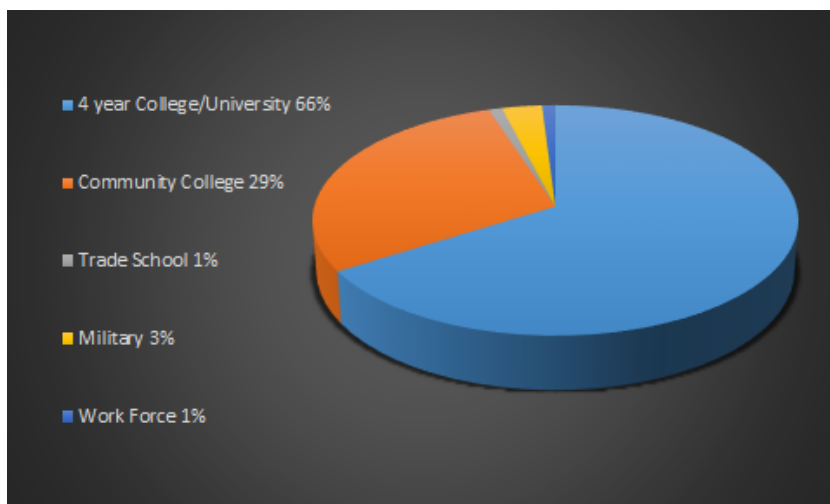
E.A.G.L.E. EDUCATION

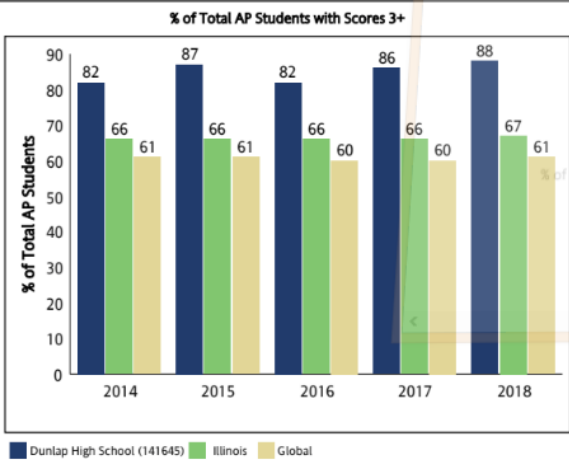
