- NEW- 2019-20 KG Registration is now OPEN	Carmel Clay Schools' Kindergarten Registration Available for 2019-20 School Year Carmel, IN – Carmel Clay Schools' kindergarten registration for the 2019-20 school year is now available. The online registration form can be accessed by copying and pasting the following link into a web browser: https://forms.ccs.kt2.in.us/ParentPortal/pages/login.aspx. Any student who is five (5) years of age on or before August 1st of the enrolling year as verified by an official birth certificate is eligible to enroll in kindergarten. There is no appeal process for early entrance. When registering children, parents/guardians will need an official birth certificate (not a hospital record) and proof of residency. Proof of residency consists of a rental agreement, purchase agreement, closing documents or deed and a utility (electric and/or gas) statement. Parents/guardians should also note that immunization records must be submitted to the school by the first day of instruction. Those records may also be scanned and uploaded online, dropped off at the school or sent by a doctor's office. ~NEW~ News from the Nurse	 Pink eye (conjunctivitis) Pink eye is most often caused by viral infections associated with the common cold. It can also be caused by bacterial infections or allergies. Children with bacterial pink eye should take antibiotic drops or ointment. These are not needed for viral pink eye. Viral and bacterial pink eye are contagious. Prevent them from spreading with good hand washing and use of alcohol-based hand rubs. Pink eye should not cause any long-term damage to a child's vision. Seek medical attention if there is a change in vision, persistent redness, eye pain, or eyelid swelling.
