



What is Mission Engagement?

Engaging is more than just counting down hours. It is actively participating in the service of others. It is being on mission to glorify God and impact the world for Christ.

I'm a **Junior**... What about me?

This year you will partner with a specific ministry organization, building a relationship with that organization as you minister to others. You will participate in four experiences with that partner organization for a minimum of 20 hours. Activities should not be part of an academic requirement or take place during the school day.

Exactly how do I do that?

- Think about your previous experiences. What have you enjoyed doing? What do you feel God has gifted you in?
- Think of an organization that does this type of ministry. It may be a community center, Charis, KARM, or another non-profit. Talk to a church/school leader, a friend, or use google to search for organizations.
- Contact the organization. Explain who you are and what your desire is. Ask if you can work with them this year. Take down the contact information for the person you will be working with.
- Make arrangements to work with the organization at least four times this year. The experiences should be progressive in their depth. For example, the first visit you may just be helping out, but by the fourth visit you could be involved in organizing an activity.
- For each experience, complete a MERF (Mission Engagement Reflection Form) on x2Vol. MERFs should be completed within 30 days of the activity. You need to have at least four of these completed by May 15 for a minimum of 20 hours.
- Submit a MERF for all your service hours, even those not with your partner organization. You can print a transcript to send with college applications.

What next?

As a senior, you will continue your partnership with the same ministry.
