Open to a graduating African-American female senior with a B+ average or above.

Christine Ponquinette Historically Black College / University Scholarship

Open to a graduating male or female senior planning to attend a Historically Black College. The individual must have a B average or better.

(Failure to attend a Historically Black College or University for any reason will result in forfeiting the scholarship.)

Janetta Hickman Merit Scholarship

Open to a graduating male or female senior with a B average or above.

Silver Cross Healthy Community Commission/Tealight Foundation, Inc. Scholarship

Open to graduating male or female senior with a B+ average or above living within the following zip codes: 60432, 60433, 60436 and Fairmont Grade School District 89.

Robert A. Meade Joliet Technologies Memorial Scholarship

Open to a graduating male or female senior with a B+ or above average pursuing a college degree in mechanical engineering.

Patricia Meade Joliet Junior College Alumni Nursing Scholarship

Open to a graduating male or female senior planning to attend Joliet Junior College. The individual must have a B+ average or better and pursuing a college degree in a nursing affiliated field.
