2. Treasurer –Everybody received a copy of the budget. We are starting the year with approximately \$54,000. This is a great amount to start the year with! Amy went over the budget and what the different categories mean. She has offered to answer any questions that parents may have.

Principle's Report: We are a Tech Academy School and have the SEAL program. A group of teachers went to a two week training at the Tech Museum. Mr. Otteson is asking if any of the parents are interested in being involved there will be a meeting September 24th. The Tech club is starting and is beginning in November. There are dance program coming up as well. Representatives will be coming in with ipads for 4th and 5th graders for one week and a dance class will be held. Then in January there will be dance classes for a week for all grades and they will perform.

This year our theme is the Seal/Stem Connection.

Special Presentation: Zach Hilton is presenting Rock and Roll Wednesdays. Dan Harney is here from City Council and another special guest with public health Martha representing the Safe Routes to School Program. They are working with public schools for traffic and pedestrian safety. They have helped with family bike nights. This is their third year and they have had a grant. This grant ends this year. They

would like to continue this even after this grant expires. They are not recruiting but would like parents to volunteer at Walk and Roll Wednesdays. They are also putting together maps that show safe walk and bike areas. She asking for parent input into developing the maps.

Dan Harney is discussing the new streets and how they have bike lanes. He is an advocate for Safe Routes for School.

Dom had a suggestion about putting up signs stating that certain neighborhoods were bike approved.

They do not want this program to go away even when the grant is gone. They are working towards meeting that goal. Maybe the HSC can sponsor a program like this? We will look into this further.
